What a six months we have had! There sure have been many twists, turns, ups and downs but whatever happens we all stand firm in the name of animal welfare.

With the incredible

support we receive we are continuing to help as many golden retrievers as we can.The charity has many contacts across Turkey now, we are getting alerted very quickly to a golden in need. The sadness is that the cruelty they are experiencing is truly heartbreaking. We are seeing a lot more cruel confinement, starvation, shooting and much worse but it's our determination to readdress the balance and get them out of their terrible situation that keeps us all focused. This is always a challenge for the team mentally, as seeing such unnecessary cruelty on a daily basis can take its toll. The great thing is we are always here to support each other in difficult times.

Emre and the team are continuing to do a great job at the centre - lovingly known as the 'Garden'.

The play park is being used every day to help promote the mental wellbeing of our rescues. It's a great place for Burcn, (the Happy Paws Trainer) to start the basic training which all our dogs seem to enjoy. Burcn can also provide a much more detailed report on their behaviour which is so helpful.

The play park is where all the trees have been planted which created the much loved memory wood. This lovely quiet area allows everyone to relax and reflect - which is very special.

On a recent visit we were all able to see the amazing benefit the play park has to offer.

Another project which was completed was 'Duncan's Den'. This lovely space allows dogs who need a quiet time after surgery or who just need a little time to relax and decompress. This project holds a very special place in my heart.



We are helping to build up the centre's Vet clinic with as much necessary and needed equipment as possible. This will help us provide a very high standard of treatments for all the dogs that are under the centre's care.

The spay and neuter programme continues to grow, Our food programme is feeding

not only our dogs but many little souls who have been abandoned - it's a sad fact that without our support many little ones simply do not survive - but thanks to your kind and continued support tummies are nice and full.

We continue to welcome more amazing families to our group and it's so wonderful to see them all embracing the joys of rescuing from our wonderful charity.

Our fundraising is going really well and we are continuing to work with a few animal Welfare Trusts and working in partnership with them to improve animal welfare has been incredible. Building relationships with other likeminded organisations is a real joy and together I feel we are making a difference.

Looking forward into the future the charity will continue to grow and flourish, it will continue to stand strong for the dogs we rescue and set up programmes to support the little ones we can't rescue - but we can make their lives worth living .You, our amazing supporters are the backbone of the charity and I would like to send my personal and heartfelt thanks to each and every one of you for joining me on this incredible journey.

#### DEXTER & PAUL



IN FEBRUARY a massive earthquake hit the East of Turkey. The very next day teams were mobilising to go to the areas that were affected. We all knew this was a huge task but we had to all do whatever we could to help the animals in their hour of need.

THE APPEAL was sent out to our supporters and we were overwhelmed by the response - vans were loaded with much needed food, water and medical supplies.

As the team set off they had no idea what they were

up against - they knew it would be difficult but what they were faced with when they finally arrived was simply heartbreaking.

VILLAGES AND TOWNS were totally destroyed - hundreds of displaced people wandering around and many hundreds of owned animals looking for their owners.

THE TEAM knew they had to act fast so the medical tent was erected, all the equipment was set up to treat the animals and a food station was set up to give owners who survived access to dog food and water.

THE TEAM WORKED TIRELESSLY to provide vet treatment for ALL the animals - their

HAPPY PAWS was very proud to help in our small way to provide the support that our Turkish friends in rescue needed so badly.



with a wonderful big brother 'Tubs' who will show him the ropes


Parker has been through so much - but thanks to the incredible support we receive he now has an amazing future ahead of him. Perfect!


