We are continuing to help as many golden's as we can and bring them to the UK to start their wonderful new lives - this has been a real challenge with all the new government regulations but we have tackled every hurdle with our usual attitude of 'let's get it done'. Finally I can announce that we have complied with everything the ministry has asked for and we should have no other issues with the transport from here on in. I am so proud as this is a real achievement.

Emre and the team are continuing to do a great job at the centre - lovingly known as the 'Garden' and we have provided many new and much needed items to improve the lives of the little ones who can't come to the UK - the most exciting area of welfare that we have achieved is providing the funds for a 'play park' a totally enclosed area where our dogs can spend time running free, learning their recall and generally having a great time. This is not only good for their physical health but super for their mental wellbeing.

The spay and neuter programme continues to grow, we are preventing many hundreds of unwanted pregnancies and this is a real success as we are finally preventing suffering.

Our food programme is feeding not only our dogs but many little souls who have been abandoned - it's a sad fact that without our support many little ones would perish. This is because of all the generous donations we are given - thanks to our wonderful supporters.

We continue to welcome more amazing families to our group and it's so wonderful to see them all embracing the joys of rescuing from our wonderful charity.

More people have offered their help regarding fundraising this year which is such a great help. It has been really exciting to see what events have been put on including a fantastic 80's night by Happy Paws mum Tracy Dunn.

We are continuing to work with a few

animal welfare Trusts and working in partnership with them to improve animal welfare has been incredible. Building relationships with other like-minded organisations is a real joy and together I feel we are making a difference. The charity continues to help the poor souls who struggle every day to survive. To improve their welfare our street dog feeding programme and general vet programme are continuing to do really well.

He thrived under our care and when he arrived to meet his new mum and dad - it was love at first sight!

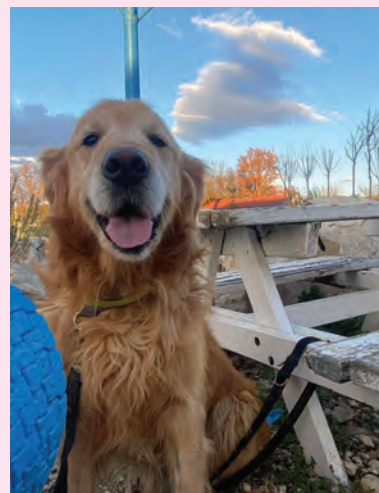
Jenson is now living the Happy Paws dream and it sure feels very special knowing he will always be safe and loved - PERFECT!!

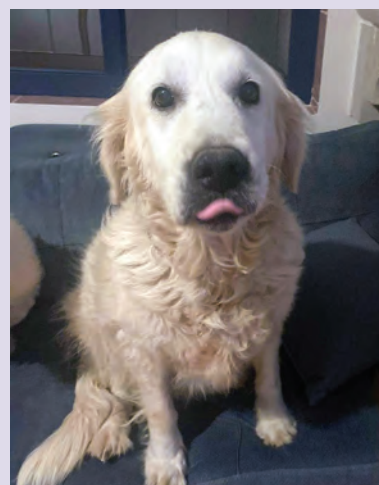

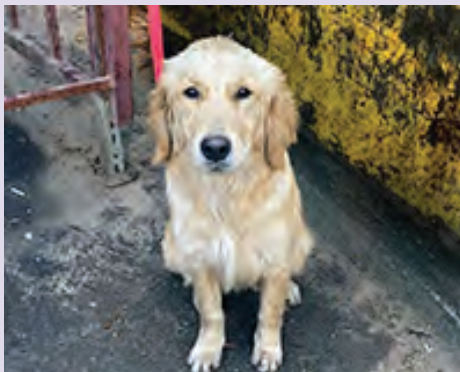
IVY - lost to loved

She was scooped up and taken back to the centre where she was given all the vet care she needed.

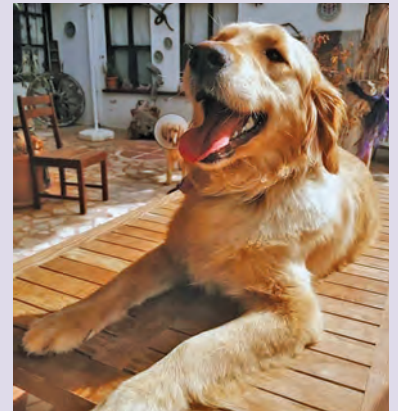

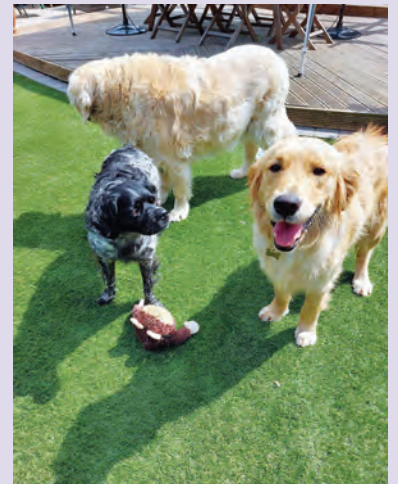

KITTY - lonely to loved

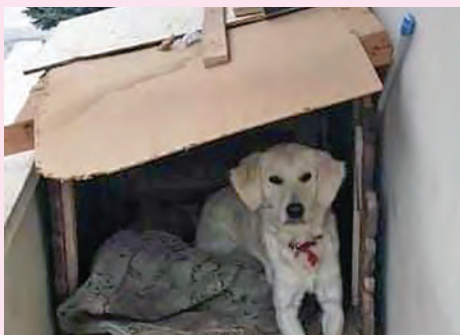
Dear Kitty was so lonely! Left on a baron balcony all alone - she had nothing! The charity stepped in and she was super happy to leave her lonely life behind.

She joined her lovely family recently and she is doing great - her family simply thinks she is perfect (which we all agreed she is).

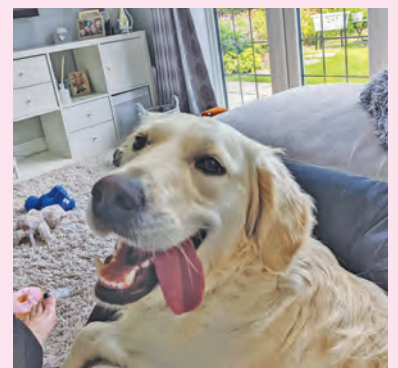
Kitty is one of the lucky ones that's a given! It's thanks to all the support we receive that she is now living the Happy Paws dream!



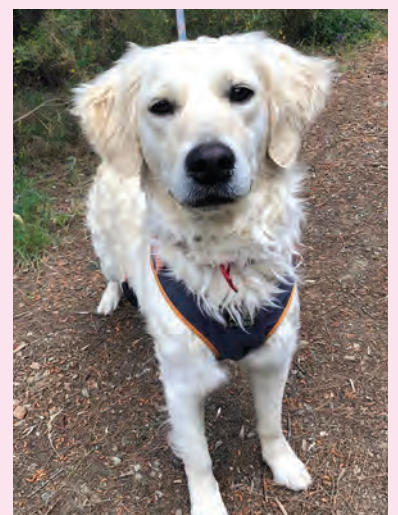

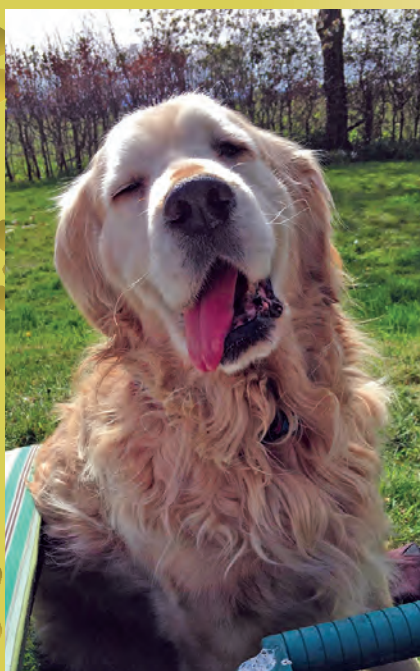

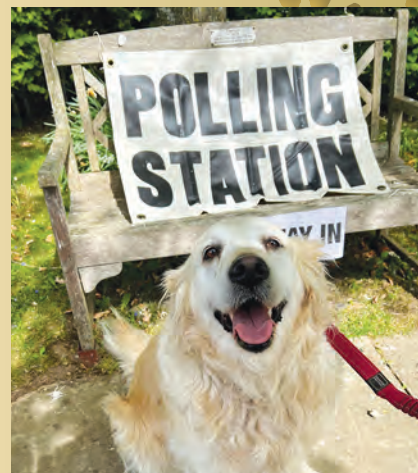
