This is only possible due to the amazing support we receive from an ever increasing team of supporters who work incredibly hard to ensure we have enough funds to embark on the work we involve ourselves with. This, to me, is very special as the friendship shown to one another is so important. We are certainly all in this together - as I always say there is no 'I' in team and at team Happy Paws I am proud to say that we are stronger than ever.

Our auction page 'Happy Paws Auction and Selling' is doing so well. Many of you know that it was Anne that set it up and that it is Anne that takes the lead on it. Because of her professional approach it runs like a well-oiled machine. This auction site raises funds and I am very grateful to Anne for doing such a great job.

Our UK co-ordinator, Lisa Birt, continues to ensure that if there is a Golden in need in the UK she will do all that she can to facilitate the re-homing process.

Lisa has helped 19 kids find new homes. Rescuing from the UK can be very emotional for a variety of different reasons but Lisa handles every situation with care, kindness and support.

This can be very challenging but Lisa does a great job and I am very blessed to have her on the team.

Ali, our home check co-ordinator, continues to arrange all home checks alongside Michelle who takes the lead on the 'Easy Fundraising' page. The work that they do for Happy Paws is invaluable and again I am so very lucky to have them on board.

Having set up the charity 18 months ago from nothing, it has, over the last year, grown and developed in to a very special organisation. Anne, Lisa, Ali and Michelle are a constant support, not only to the charity, but to me personally. For all of the team it can be stressful, emotionally draining and difficult but we are always here for each other - and



we have our rescue kids too - as my picture shows when the going gets tough a good 'thank you for saving me' cuddle makes it all worthwhile and makes us more determined than ever.

Happy Paws has made many new contacts. We are now working in partnership to secure the safety of many more Golden Retrievers in need from Bosnia, Romania, Cyprus, Spain and Turkey. The rescuers we work with are at the very sharp end of all the rescues. I have such respect and admiration for these amazing people.

The horrors they see on a daily basis is, quite frankly, mind-blowing but they take these souls off the streets, out of pounds and kill shelters and give them hope. If we are contacted for help then Happy Paws takes full responsibility for them financially, which takes the heavy burden of raising funds away from the other organisation. This in turn helps them rescue more souls.

So to the future. Well my aim is to encourage more people to get involved, to secure support from local businesses and try to secure funding where ever possible.

The fact is the more money we have, the more Golden Retrievers we can save.

So on behalf of the kids we have saved, the kids we are saving and the ones we just haven't found yet, but we will - thank you!

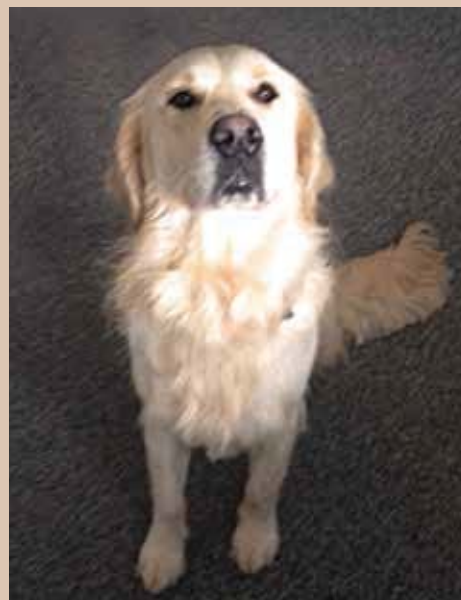
Together we can make a difference - I know we can't change the world but to the kids we save it does change their world and that's why we do what we do.

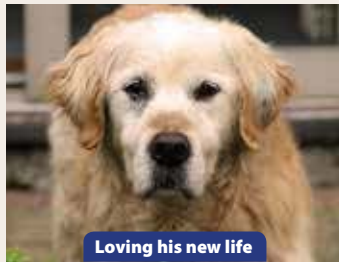

This was the best ever outcome for Sonny - we at team Happy Paws could not be happier for him.



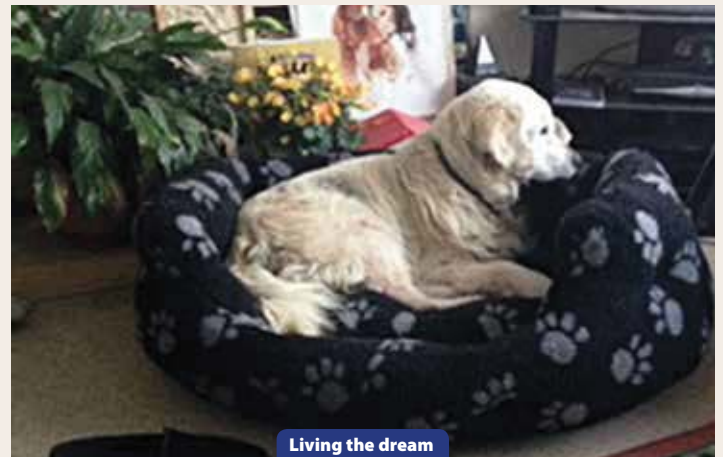

Happy Paws loves to spoil our new arrivals with a very special welcome blanket, knitted especially for our kids. They are all hand-made with love from a very special group of ladies.

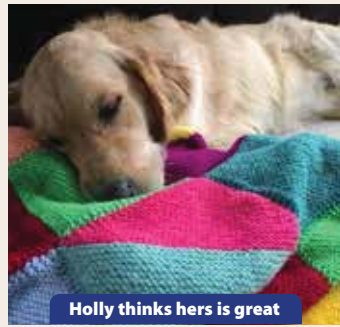

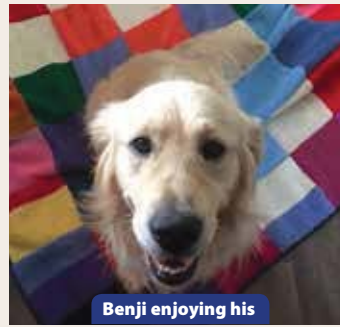

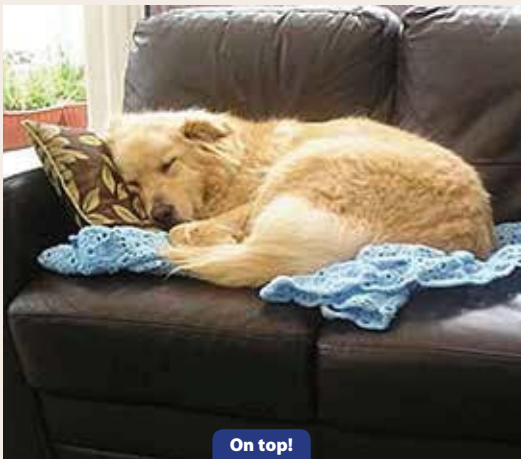

We started to rescue from Turkey and soon discovered there were so many Golden Retrievers in need.

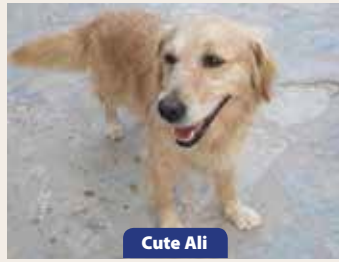
To be honest, it took us all by surprise just how many needed help. As a small charity we took a deep breath and got on with the job.

It costs approximately £1300 to rescue each Golden as we have to wait four months before they can travel. Therefore the foster costs are much higher than Europe.

So here are some of the lucky ones who now come under the Happy Paws umbrella.

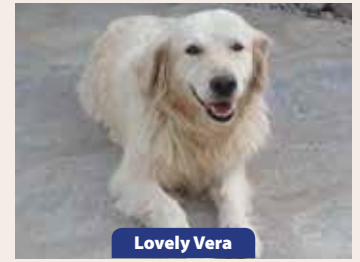

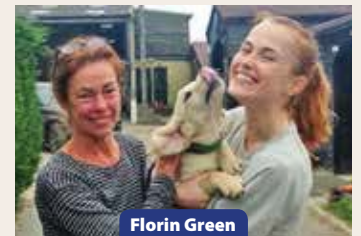
