Social Security Card	If married filing jointly, you will need the same credentials for your spouse.	
W2's & 1099's	If married filing jointly, you will need the same credentials for your spouse.	
Dependents: Copies of Social Security Cards & Date Of Birth Number of Dependents	Only needed if claiming dependents.	
Pin Number Letter Previously Received From IRS	This is only if the IRS has previously sent you PIN letters to file yearly. If you don't have one, don't worry about it.	
All Correspondence Letters Received From IRS	I.e. Federal, local, and/or state entities, that you have received in regards to any owed taxes, liens, or informational contents.
