

## **INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS**

- 1. The **Becki King Memorial Scholarship**, offered by the Paradise Coast Chapter of The Ninety-Nines, Inc. is open to all 99s residing in Florida. Applicants must be members or student members of The Ninety-Nines, Inc. at the time of submitting their scholarship application.
- 2. <u>Application submission</u>: Please submit your FULLY COMPLETED AND SIGNED application packet as one .PDF file via email to the Paradise Coast Chapter Scholarship Chair <u>paradisecoast99s@gmail.com</u>. "Scholarship Application" must be included in the subject line. Expect a confirmation of receipt within 36 hours.
- 3. <u>Application packet:</u> Carefully review your application packet to ensure all required items are included in the packet. Completed scholarship application packets must be <u>RECEIVED</u> BY April 15, 2024. Scholarship packets shall contain:
  - Official application signed and dated
  - Legible copies of all aviation certificates
  - Legible copy of current medical certificate
  - Legible copy of last 3 pages of your pilot logbook (if applicable)
  - Typed descriptive essay (1,000 words max)
- Professional résumé
- 2 letters of recommendation (1 page max for each letter)
- Proof of Florida residency (legible copy of driver's license, voter registration, utility bill)
- Written FAA test results (if applicable for the rating sought)
- **4.** Among those applicants seeking ratings which require an FAA written test, preference will be given to applicants who have passed the written test.
- Include in your scholarship essay (1,000 words max) •the projected cost of flight training and materials for the rating being sought. •Address how you plan to fund the balance of your training if you receive this award.
   •Please indicate your aviation and/or career goals, and how this scholarship will help you attain these.
   •Please share what you feel *uniquely* qualifies you for this scholarship, and •how you have supported and plan to continue to support the mission of The Ninety-Nines. •Additionally, you can include: your initial interest in aviation; challenges or obstacles you have overcome pursue your flight training; aviation-related activities or organizations in which you participate.
- 6. Scholarship winners will be notified on or before May 1, 2024.
- 7. All award money will be paid to the training institution, flight instructor, or applicant as determined by Scholarship Chair. All training must be completed by **June 30, 2025** (unless otherwise defined by the scholarship donor). Progress reports shall be provided to the scholarship chair as requested by the scholarship chair.
- 8. Neither The Ninety-Nines, Inc., nor their members, agents, or representatives, are responsible for the quality of any training received with this scholarship, nor for any accident, incident, or any other event which may occur while the recipient of this scholarship is performing flight training or activities relating thereto, and recipient agrees to hold harmless the above entities upon receipt of the scholarship.
