

CONSTRUCTION LABORER

Job description

JOB SUMMARY

The position of construction laborer consists of performing tasks involving physical labor at building and construction sites. It also consists of operating hand and power tools of all types, cleaning and preparing sites, digging trenches, setting braces to support the sides of excavations, cleaning up rubble and debris and removing construction waste materials.

TASKS/SKILLS(not limited to)

- Clean or prepare construction sites to eliminate possible hazards;
- Control traffic passing near, in or around work zones;
- Dig ditches or trenches, backfill excavations or compact and level earth to grade specifications, using picks, shovels, tampers or rakes;
- Erect or dismantle scaffolding, shoring, braces, ramps or other temporary structures;
- Load, unload or identify building materials, machinery or tools, distributing them to the appropriate locations, according to project plans or specifications;
- Signal equipment operators to facilitate alignment, movement, or adjustment of machinery, equipment or materials;
- Adhere to established safety rules and regulations and maintain a clean and safe work environment; you are responsible for your own safety and the safety of those around you;

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be able to take direction and work independently;
- Complete job tasks with attention to detail, quality and an ability to stay on task until finished;
- Be productive on the job site; if you complete a task, ask for another or use time to clean until project manager can give you another task.
