- 132 Kings Row Seems to be Abandoned
  Since this meeting, the property has been repossessed by the lender. The property has been cleaned up and is for sale.
- 6. Road Issues and Repairs on Kings Row (Regarding Road Repair completed in August, 2024)
  - There was a conversation about the road work not being executed as planned and concerns about the POA Board not administrating the work.
  - Additional concerns were discussed regarding the warranty work not completed. Keith King shared that the asphalt company would do the warranty work, but that the owner of the company was dealing with some personal and family medical issues.
  - Additional discussions were brought up about spending additional money on the road.
