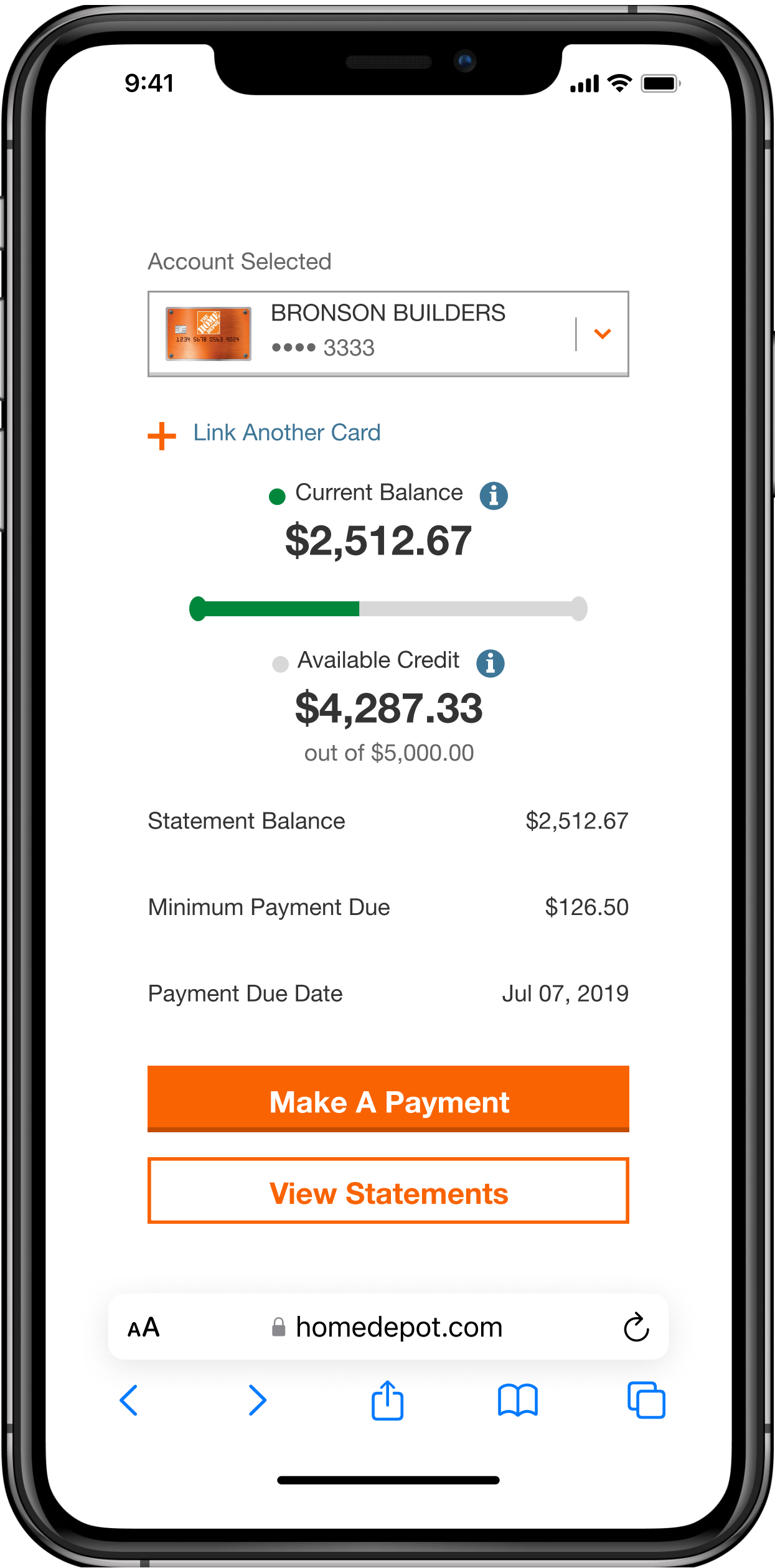

# Legacy Account Snapshot

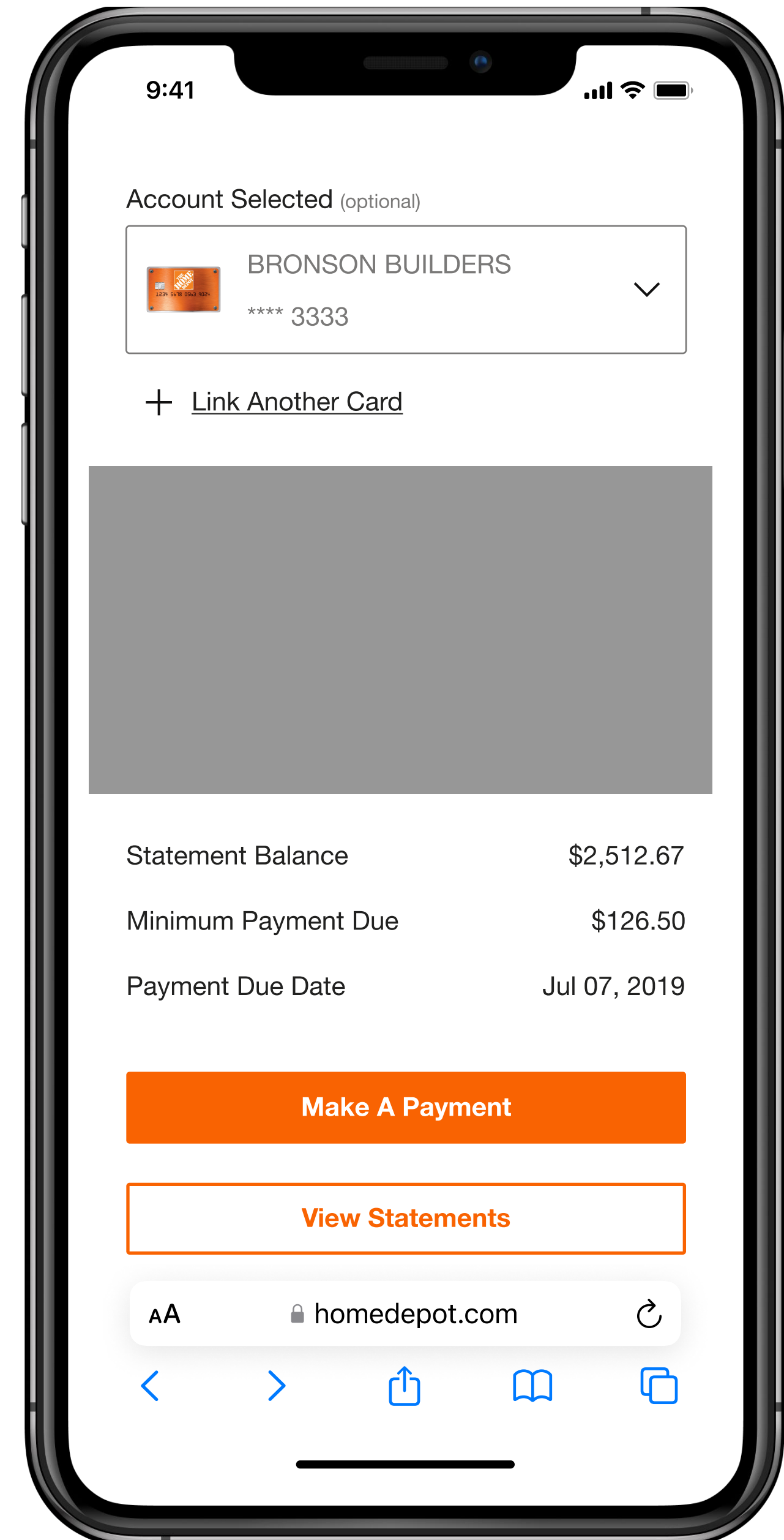


**HomeDepot.Com began updating the site and app's UI in order to make the site easier to use.**

**The Home Depot Credit Card Account Snapshot was the first page to be updated.**

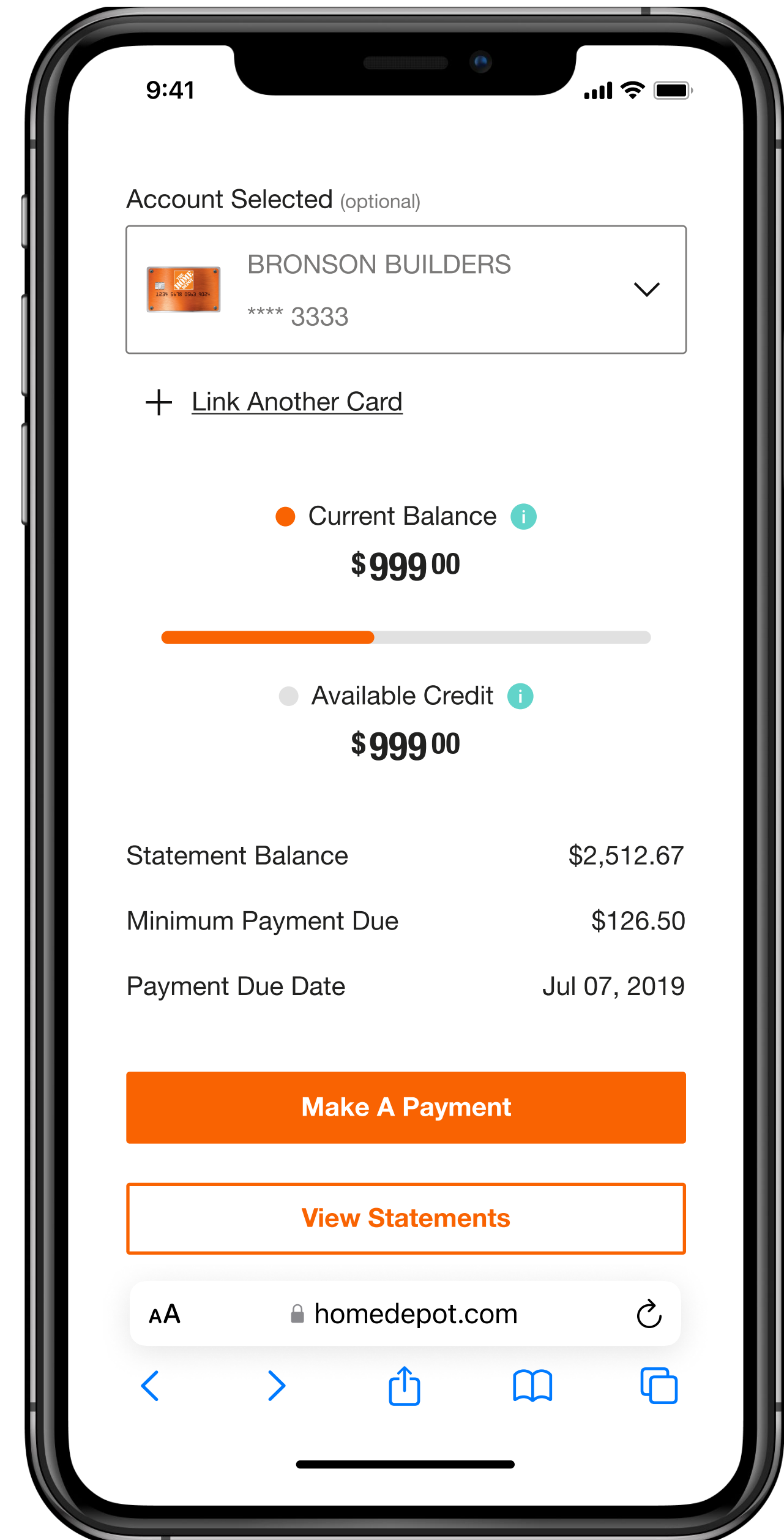
**We began updating the page, but did not have all necessary components as they were not built yet.**

**The new UI system lacked a payment tracker**

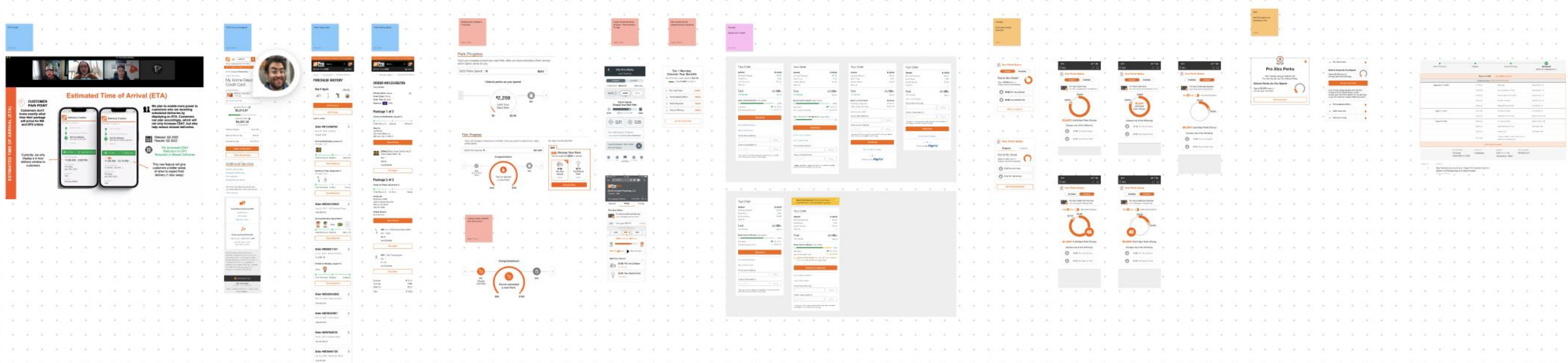




I designed this Intermediate Payment Tracker component based on the existing Delivery Tracker component in our design system, so we could begin development without waiting on the Payment Tracker component.



**I drove alignment between seven other teams that were also blocked from finishing their designs because they were in need of a tracker component.**



**We shared our designs with each other in a design session via Miro and then presented our work from the session to the visual Ops team showing an immediate need for a tracker component, which expedited the Beta release of the component.**

While I worked on the Account Snapshot Page, our Homepage team worked on a miniature version on a credit card account snapshot “pod.”

I delegated the Homepage team to work on the tracker and it’s different states.

**Having the Homepage Team focus on the tracker, allowed me to move forward on redesigning the B2B Credit Card Account Pages.**

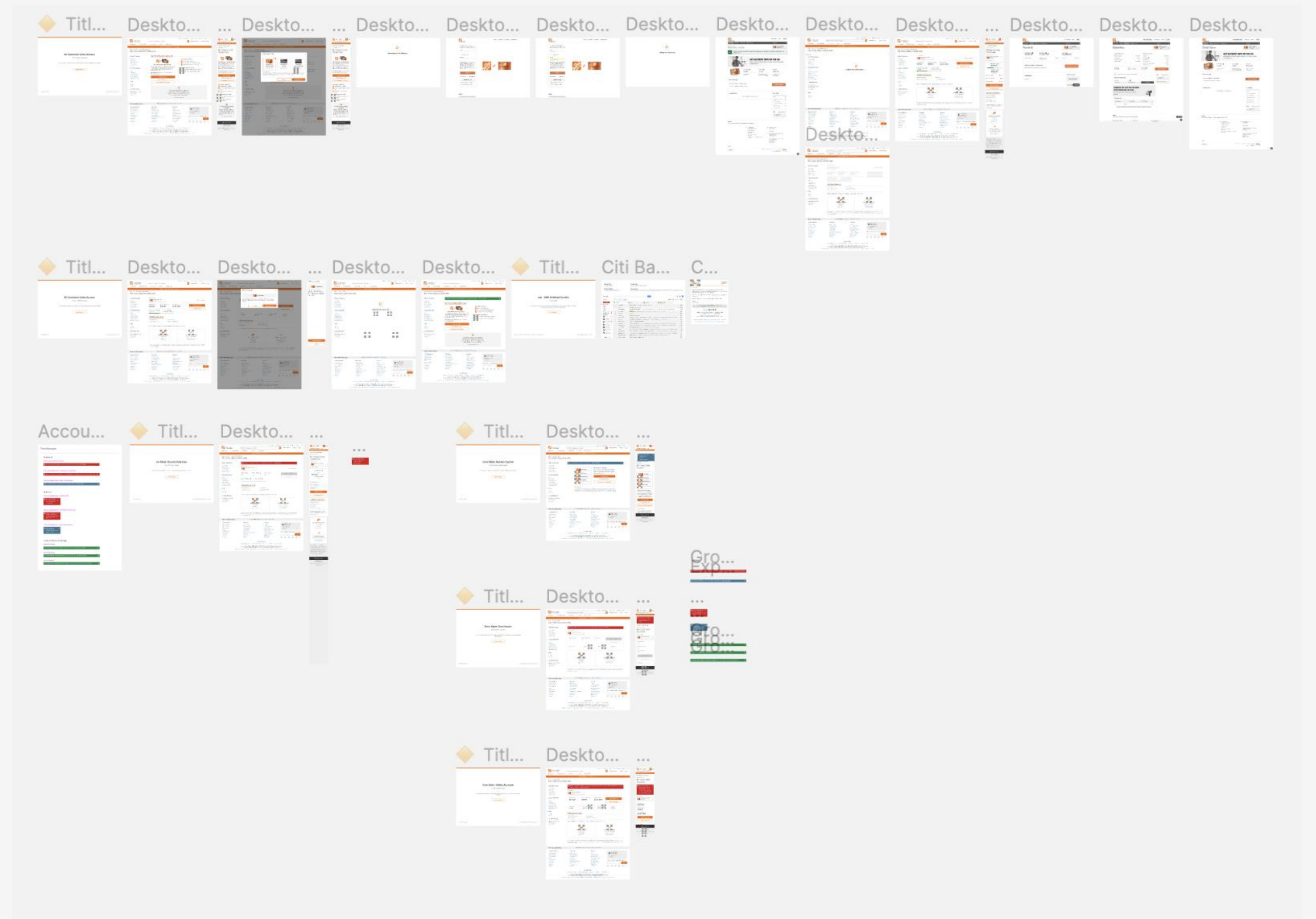
**The B2B pages required additional work due to B2B specific features like proxy account management and the ability for users to export an invoice.**

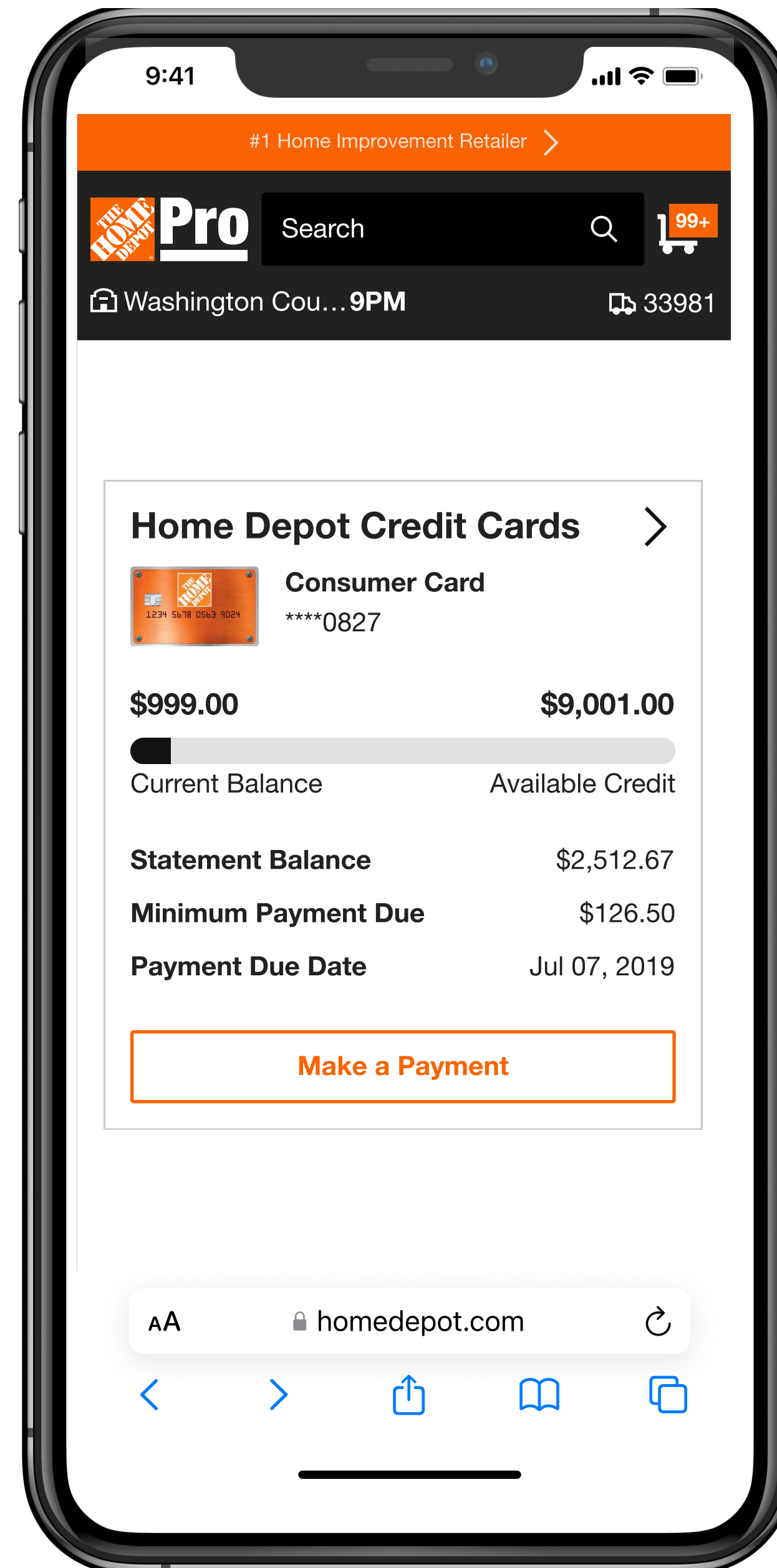


**By partnering with Homepage,

three months ahead of schedule**

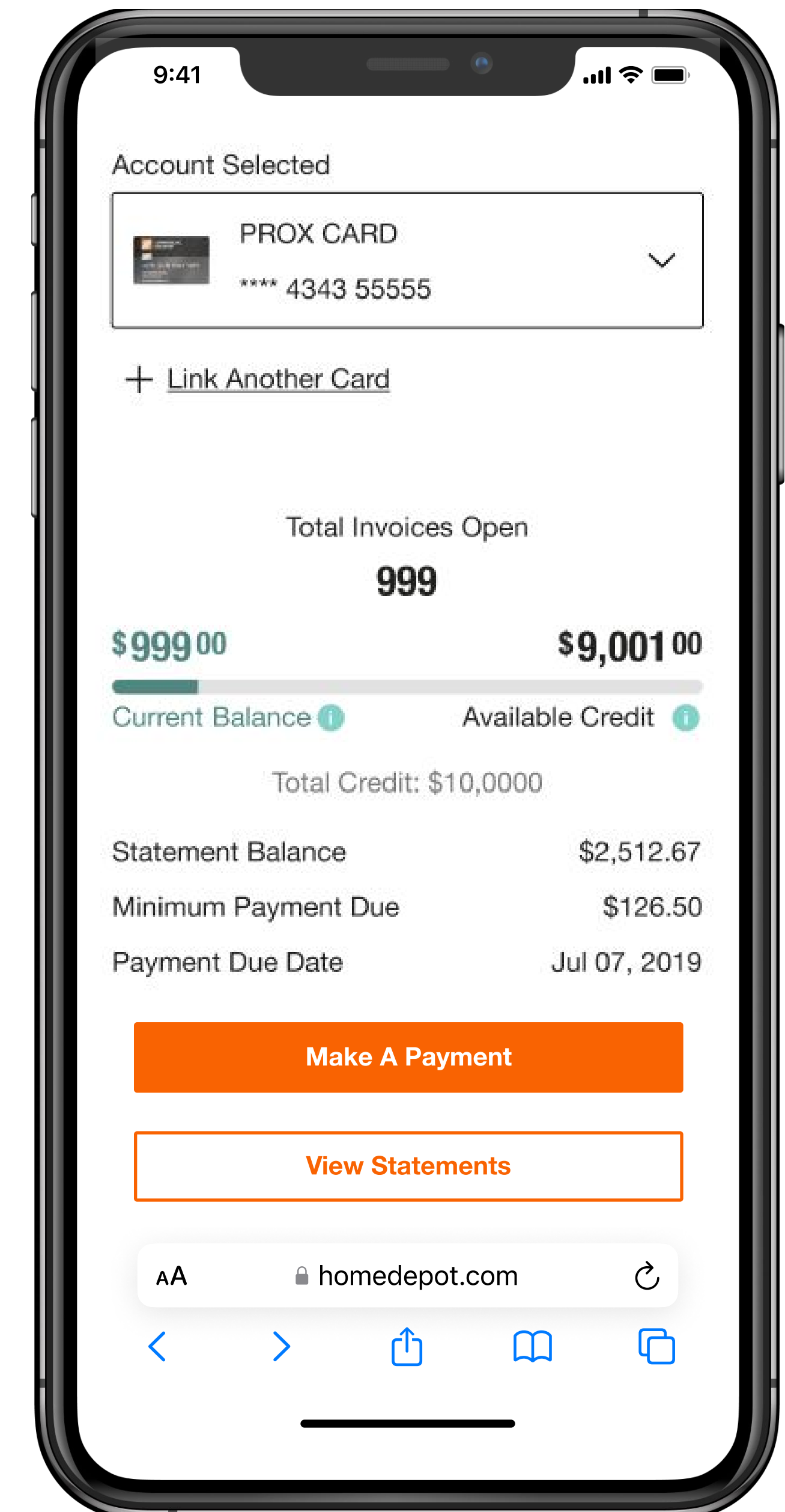
