



When you call law enforcement:

- Provide law enforcement with the information in this safety kit. Tell them when you noticed your child was missing and what clothing he or she was wearing.
- Request law enforcement authorities immediately enter your child's name and identifying information into the FBI's National Crime Information Center Missing Person File.
- Request that law enforcement put out a Be On the Look Out (BOLO) bulletin.

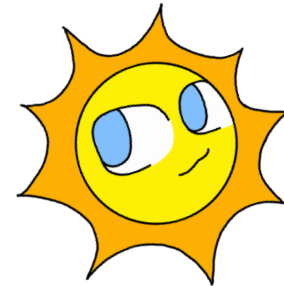

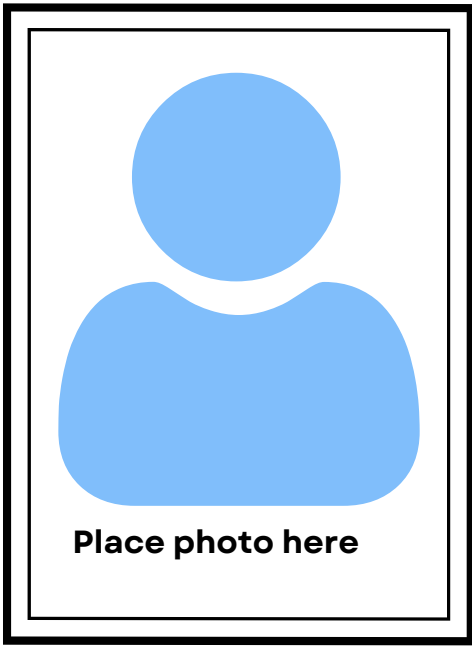
