Introducing the public to Barbera and Nebbiolo (Dolcetto too) has been a privilege and a joy for us. They are unique, distinct, and delicious wines. And we are proud to be the pioneers of these types of wines in the PNW.

Varietals: 100% Nebbiolo

Vineyard: 100% McKinley Springs

Appellation: Horse Heaven Hills

Aging: 16 months in American Oak

Cases produced: 320

Profile: While most of our red wines are fruit-forward and intense, our Nebbiolo is the exception. Subtle and nuanced, flavors of dried figs and cherry slowly give way to sweet herbs and toast on the palate. Our latest Reserve Nebbiolo is graceful and thought-provoking, a wine to share with fellow wine lovers. Enjoy now or hold for more complex treat in the future.

Profile: This vintage of Estate Barbera is a throwback to the more traditional style of Italian Barbera- bright, intense, and demanding. Flavors of Rainier cherry, wild raspberry, and cran-apple are followed by a long, mouth-watering finish. This is a great wine to pair with rich, Italian dishes. Thanks to the wine's high acidity, it will also age well.

2024 Reserve Blood Red Barbera

Varietals: 100% Barbera

Vineyard: 100% Cascade Cliffs

Appellation: Horse Heaven Hills

Aging: 16 months in American Oak

Profile: Our most popular wine presents a dilemma of sorts for us; keeping Blood Red Barbera in stock has become difficult, as the demand for this cult wine continues to grow every year. This vintage is one of the more shameless, over-the-top versions of Blood Red, with ripe, candied fruit from start to finish. Jammy flavors of cherry preserves, warm berry pie, and Kirsch give way to a long, intense finish.

Drink: Now to 2033

**A Brief History of Cascade Cliffs and
Piedmont Varietals.**

- 1988: Nebbiolo is planted on our Estate Vineyard. This is the second oldest planting of Nebbiolo in the Pacific NW.
- 1990: The original block of Barbera is planted on our Estate Vineyard. This is the oldest planting of Barbera in the Pacific NW.
- 1999: A second block of Barbera - "Kinda Old Barbera" - is planted next to the Old Barbera. The fence line Barbera that borders HWY 14 is also planted.
- 2000: A third block of Barbera, "Baby Barbera", is planted on the vineyard.
- 2005: Dolcetto is planted on our Estate Vineyard.
- 2019: Arneis, a Piedmont white/green grape, is planted on our Estate Vineyard.
