

BORDEAUX CLUB

Our Bordeaux Club caters to lovers of wine like Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Merlot, and blends that have these varietals in them. These three grapes are known as “Bordeaux varietals” since they have roots in this region of France. Washington state has a long history of cultivating these varietals and producing world-class wine made from them. Not only are these wines highly recognizable to the public, they have a natural advantage over many other wines with their ability to age well in the bottle.

Our history with Bordeaux varietals began in 1986, when the first vines - Merlot - were planted on our property. Cabernet Sauvignon was planted in 1998, and we now work with Malbec, sourced from AVAs like Horse Heaven Hills and Red Mountain, every year. The current Spring Bordeaux Club package contains a fantastic mix of wine that includes an Estate-Grown wine, two beautiful examples of Red Mountain Cabernet and Merlot, and a delicious blend of Cab, Malbec, and Merlot. Here is the line-up:



2026 Spring Bordeaux Club

- **3 bottles of 2022 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon. Retail = \$65/bottle.**
- **3 bottles of 2022 Winemaker's Select Cabernet Sauvignon. Retail = \$65/bottle.**
- **3 bottles of 2022 Red Mountain Merlot. Retail = \$45/bottle.**
- **3 bottles of 2023 Homage (Cab-Merlot-Malbec). Retail = \$45/bottle.**

2022 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

Varietals: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard: 100% Cascade Cliffs

Appellation: Columbia Valley

Aging: 12 months in American Oak

Cases produced: 250

Profile: We saved the very last bit of this wine for our Bordeaux Club members. Our 2022 Estate Cab is more of a wild and racy style than some of other versions, offering flavors of dark currant, cola, and clove. The tannins and acidity are present but more in the background, allowing this wine to be enjoyed with or without food. It drinks great right now, but will continue to improve in the bottle.

Drink: Now to 2031.

2023 Homage

Varietals: 59% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 19% Malbec.

Vineyard: 70% McKinley Springs, 30% Coyote Canyon.

Appellation: Horse Heaven Hills

Aging: 12 months in American Oak

Cases produced: 875

Profile: The three varietals used in this tribute to the great wines of Bordeaux work together to offer loads of dark berry/cherry flavors up front, and a gripping, dry finish. The Cabernet provides the foundation of the wine, the Merlot gives a plush texture, and the Malbec offers sweet tannins. This is a fun, yet serious wine that will pair well with heavier dishes and is enjoyable as a casual sipper as well.

Drink: Now to 2028.

2022 Winemaker's Select Cabernet Sauvignon

Varietals: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard: 100% Quintessence

Appellation: Red Mountain

Aging: 12 months in American Oak

Cases produced: 330

Profile: Our "Winemaker's Select" series highlights our favorite vineyard sites and preferred lots of fruit for specific varietals. The 2022 WS Cabernet Sauvignon is another fine example of how good Red Mountain's Bordeaux varietals are. Bold and serious now, this wine will get more seamless in time.

Flavors of black cherry, mint, and cocoa mingle nicely and are followed by a warm, mouth-watering finish.

Try pairing this wine with grilled ribeye steaks and aged, dry cheeses.

Drink: Now to 2034.

2022 Red Mountain Merlot

Varietals: 100% Merlot

Vineyard: 85% Scooteny Flats, 15% Rattlesnake Hills.

Appellation: Red Mountain.

Aging: 12 months in American Oak

Cases produced: 580

Profile: Our 2022 Merlot relies heavily on Red Mountain fruit, with a touch of fruit from Rattlesnake Hills, near Yakima. Plush and easy-drinking, this wine can still hold up to heavy foods and will age well for years to come. Black plum and ripe cherry flavors are wrapped up nicely by moderate tannins and acidity. A great sipping wine, yet serious and age-worthy.

Drink: Now to 2030.
