# Reserves

\*Aged 18 - 20 months in American Oak



## Reserve Nebbiolo 2022/Reserve Nebbiolo 2023: \$75.

**Club: \$56**

Nebbiolo might be the most mysterious wine in the world, lighter in color than most red wines, yet full of intriguing, complex flavors like dried cherries, herbal tea, and fall spices. The attack is subtle, but the finish is strong and demanding. Made from 100% McKinley Springs Vineyard, this is a beautiful, elegant wine to pair with gourmet meals, celebrations, or a gathering with your cork-dork friends. And due to its naturally high tannin and acidity, a wine that can be safely laid down for years.

## Reserve Sangiovese 2023: \$75. **Club: \$56**

We've been producing Sangiovese for many years now, using this classic Italian varietal to make single-varietal and blended wines. And now, here is your first Reserve version of Sangiovese, a bigger, bolder example that is reminiscent of the great Brunello wines of Montalcino.

Made from McKinley Springs fruit from the Horse Heaven Hills AVA, this wine has the classic brightness of Sangiovese with a dreamy combination of bright red and deep, dark fruit on the palate. Dusty tannins and a long, dry finish wrap things up nicely on the finish. Aged for 20 months in half-new, half- used barrels, this is a delicious tribute to the "Blood of Italy".

## Reserve Avanzo 2022: \$75. **Club: \$56**

Avanzo has become a cult favorite with the Cascade Cliffs loyal. This vintage, we broke free from the Super Piedmont style and went rogue with a blend of 42% Merlot, 23% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Barbera, 10% Nebbiolo, and 7% Syrah. Call it a French-Italian hybrid. The dark, plush fruit from the Cab, Merlot, and Syrah, dance effortlessly with the brighter, edgier aspects of Barbera and Nebbiolo, creating a gorgeous waltz of flavors and textures. Here is a wine that will please anyone and everyone, full of twists and turns that will age well for many years.



## Reserve Red Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon 2023: \$90. **Club: \$67**

Our Reserve Red Mountain Cab has become one of our most celebrated and impressive wines, winning Gold, Double Gold, and Platinum medals. The 2023 vintage is no exception, displaying an impressive structure and a generous flavor profile for a wine so young. There's a reason why we submit these wines to competitions... Made from Quintessence Vineyard fruit in the Red Mountain AVA, this is an excellent example of how good WA State Cabernet Sauvignon can be. Heady aromas of clove and spiced fruit are followed by mouth-watering flavors of black cherry, black currant, and sweet herbs.

## Reserve Blood Red Barbera 2021/2022/2023: \$100. **Club: \$75**

The 2023 Blood Red Barbera (BRB) was released early this year, and it quickly gained a reputation as being one of the more "Blood Red" Blood Red Barberas... In other words, this vintage of BRB is an incredibly rich, fruit-forward wine, packed with juicy cherry and dark berry flavors from start to finish. We held back a number of barrels to age longer, realizing this might be one of the better Reserve Blood Red Barbera wines we've made. Aged for 20 months in half-new, half-used barrels, the wine picked up even more layers of toasty flavors, yet still has the varietal's trademark brightness on the finish. A powerful and delicious treat for the senses.

## Winemaker's Select Cabernet Sauvignon 2022/ Winemaker's Select Cabernet Sauvignon 2023: \$65.

**Club: \$48**

Our Cabernet Sauvignon wines are still “secret weapons” of Cascade Cliffs, providing fans of this royal varietal with outstanding options to choose from. Besides growing our own Cab here at the estate, we also source it from Horse Heaven Hills and Red Mountain- two of the state’s best growing areas for Bordeaux varietals. The 2022 Winemaker's Select (WS) Cabernet Sauvignon is made from 100% Red Mountain fruit and aged one year in the barrel. This wine has plenty of fruit and grip, a complex, delicious, and serious wine that will age very well. Black cherry, clove, and mission fig flavors are wrapped up neatly with balancing acidity and semi-sweet tannins.

## Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2022: \$65. Club: \$48

We don't always have enough of our own Cabernet Sauvignon to make an exclusive estate version. But the 2022 vintage gave us beautifully ripe, well-balanced, and abundant fruit on our property. Fleshy and ripe, this is a Cab that drinks beautiful. Flavors of dark berries, cola, and sweet spices dance on the palate, reminding us that “we're home.” Enjoy now or hold for a future love affair.

## Red Mountain Merlot 2022: \$45. Club: \$33

The reputation of Merlot has taken a beating over the years, thanks to sloppy practices by large-scale producers in the vineyard and winery. Don't be fooled... Merlot is still a classic and delicious wine when treated correctly. Our 2022 RM Merlot relies heavily on Red Mountain fruit, with a touch of fruit from Rattlesnake Hills, near Yakima. Plush and easy-drinking, this wine can still hold up to heavy foods and will age well for years to come. Black plum and cherry flavors are wrapped up nicely by moderate tannins and acidity. A great sipping wine, yet serious and age-worthy.

## Winemaker's Select Malbec 2023: \$65. Club: \$48

Our latest Red Mountain Malbec continues to showcase how Red Mountain fruit offers the best of Bordeaux varietals in Washington State. When Malbec is made at this level, it offers an impressive combination of Cab Sauv's power and Merlot's plush fruit. Dark cherry/berry flavors are wrapped nicely by sweet tannins and a firm, long finish. Pairing this wine with beef and lamb dishes is a natural fit and will be for many years to come.

## Petite Sirah 2023: \$65. Club: \$48

Our 2023 vintage of Petite Sirah is a bigger, darker, and more varietally correct wine than the previous vintage. Made from McKinley Springs fruit in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA, it has deep color and chewy flavors of warm black and blueberry pie. Soft acidity allows this wine to be enjoyed now, even with its ample tannins.

## Homage 2023: \$45. Club: \$33

“Homage” is our tribute to the great red blends of Bordeaux, France. Made from Horse Heaven Hills fruit, we blended 59% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, and 19% Malbec to create this classic red blend. These three varietals work together for this full-bodied wine that offers loads of dark berry/cherry flavors up front, and a gripping, dry finish. While our 2023 Homage drinks well now, it will continue to improve in the bottle for many years.

# Whites

## Gewürztraminer 2024: \$35. Club: \$26

This pink-skinned varietal is best known in Germany and France's Alsace region, creating aromatic and rich white wines. Made from locally sourced Gorge fruit, our 2024 vintage is an off-dry style with plenty of ripe pear, peach and mango flavors.

## Estate Symphony 2024: \$40. Club: \$30

One of the more unique and rare varietals, Symphony is the creation of crossing Muscat of Alexandria and Grenache Gris. Planted here in 1990, we have used this varietal to make dry, off-dry, blended, and even sparkling wines. This current vintage is a dry style, with little to no residual sugar, perfect for the warmer weather. Aromas and flavors of citrus fruit, pineapple, and guava are cleaned up nicely with a refreshingly dry finish.

## Estate Arneis 2024: \$35. Club: \$26

We planted this Italian white varietal here on the property in 2019, using cuttings from another NW vineyard. Fermented and aged in stainless steel, our 2024 Arneis offers tropical aromatics and flavors of Bartlett pear, honey, and apricot. This is the newest member of the Piedmont family in our vineyard.

## Petroglyph White 2023: \$35. Club: \$26

Our Petroglyph White is a wild and juicy blend of Gewürztraminer (44%), Riesling (12%), and our own Estate-grown Symphony (44%) grape. All three of these varietals were fermented and aged separately in stainless steel tanks and then blended prior to bottling. This blend is packed with exotic aromas and flavors of tropical fruits, lemon-lime, and green pear. The fruit for this delicious blend was sourced from a combination of our own vineyard, as well as Borderline vineyard here in the Gorge, and Coyote Canyon vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA. This wine is off-dry, with a vibrant, mouth-watering finish.

## Roussanne 2023: \$35. Club: \$26

Roussanne is a white varietal, home to France's Rhone Valley. It is often blended with its "sister" grapes, Viognier and Marsanne. Sourcing the fruit from the Horse Heaven Hills AVA, this is an unoaked, crisp, and delightful white wine, perfect for the summer months. Subtle flavors of yellow apple and honeysuckle are followed by a soft finish.

## Chardonnay 2023: \$35. Club: \$26

Our 2023 Chardonnay is made from a combination of local Columbia Gorge and Horse Heaven Hills fruit. It did not go through secondary or Malolactic fermentation, keeping it crisp and clean. And like all our white wines, it is made without any oak aging, ensuring the fruit is the star of the show and not the oak. Subtle flavors of green apple and lemon-lime are followed with a soft, dry finish. You can pair this wine with many types of food, but it's also a great choice for casual sipping without any food as well.

## Estate Barbera Rosé 2024: \$35. Club: \$26

Our latest rosé is made in a dry, crisp, and vibrant style reminiscent of classic European rosés. It is unashamedly bright, teeming with pink grapefruit and sour cherry flavors with a long, mouth-watering finish. This is a great rosé to pair with briny seafoods like caviar, sushi, and most shellfish. It would also be a perfect complement to lighter charcuterie and fresh spring salads. Moreover, it is made from our very own Barbera, first planted here in 1990.

# Limited Inventory



## Sangiovese 2022: \$45. Club: \$33

Being the most planted red varietal there, Sangiovese is known as "The Blood of Italy". It is the grape used to make Chianti, Vino Nobile, and Brunello, some of Italy's best-known and most celebrated red wines. For our 2022 Sangio, we combined fruit from McKinley Springs Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA and Chukar Ridge Vineyard here in the Gorge and barrel-aged the wine for 12 months. It has the classic Italian style of high-quality Chianti wines- bright flavors of dried cherry and wild strawberry, with a refreshingly dry finish. Some say Pinot Noir is the most food-friendly red wine, but with its trademark acidity and drier style, you could argue that Sangiovese is even better.

## Paisan 2022: \$45. Club: \$33

"Paisan" is our Tuscan-style red blend, a tribute to the red blends of Tuscany. Italy produces lots of blends, from all over the country. But the red blends from Tuscany/Toscana are the most famous. Our 2022 Paisan is a neat and tidy blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (50%), Merlot (25%), and Sangiovese (25%). Half of the fruit used to make this wine was sourced from Red Mountain, and the other half from Horse Heaven Hills. The Cab and Merlot provide structure and body, while the Sangio gives the wine brightness. Harmonious layers of dark cherry, clove, and Stanley plum mingle nicely with soft tannins and moderate acidity, making this wine an easy-going, yet intriguing sipper.

## Blood Red Barbera 2022: \$85. Club: \$63

Surprisingly, this vintage of Blood Red Barbera is a bit drier than some of our other versions. Still, it is a dark and rich fruit bomb, full of ripe and showy flavors of blackberry preserves, cherry cordial, and toasty maple. The finish is also impressive with a long mouth-watering sensation after each sip. In order to make any of our wines into the "Blood Red" style, the sugar levels in the fruit need to be fairly high to begin with- and the resulting alcohol level, therefore, will be correspondingly high! Despite the stout 16% ABV, this is one of the more balanced Blood Red Barberas we've made, and a great option for both seasoned Barbera drinkers and newcomers to this wine.



## Reserve HHH Cabernet Sauvignon: \$85. Club: \$63

The folks in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA might have something to say about who grows the best Cabernet Sauvignon in WA State. And they would have a good argument... Our 2022 RSV HHH Cab Sauv, made from 100% McKinley Springs Vineyard is another example of how good this fruit is. Rich, yet focused, firm yet generous, this is a wine that will knock your socks off now, but just wait a few years and taste what it becomes. Aged 20 months in barrel, the tannins are bit tight right now, but they will soften in time and marry well with the fruit and acid.

# Futures



## Estate Dolcetto 2024 \$40. Club: \$30

Planted in 2005, our Estate Dolcetto has provided a unique element to our Piedmont varietal wines for many years now. This latest version is another classic and varietally- correct style of Dolcetto, medium-bodied, pleasant, and easy-going. Flavors of wild strawberry and brambly fruit are surrounded by soft acidity and tannins, resulting in a versatile, dry house wine that could pair with many types of dishes or utilized for casual sipping.

## Non-vintage Black Label Goat Head Red \$40. Club: \$30

That's right, folks, another Goat Head Red (GHR), this time a special release of the Black Label and an Italian twist for the GHR... We were contemplating making a different wine from this roughly 50% Barbera, 50% Nebbiolo blend, but after tasting how fruit-forward, playful, and juicy it turned out, we decided there was only one title for it- All hail the Goat! This is a richer, jammier style of GHR, more aligned with our Ami or even Blood Red Barbera wines. Shameless and oozing with lip-smacking flavors of cherry pie, fruit leather, and dried red fruit, this is a holiday gift for you that keeps on giving. This limited-release GHR will be a lower production release than most of our Goat Head Red, roughly 600 cases, so don't miss out!

## Blood Red Barbera 2024 \$90. Club: \$67

Made from the legendary Block 11 section of McKinley Springs Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA, this is Barbera at its richest and ripest. The fruit is powerful and jammy on the attack, encompassing and focused on the mid-palate, and long-lasting on the finish. Creamy and luscious flavors of black cherry preserves, sun-drenched berries, and warm maple are followed by a finish that goes on and on. At 17.7 % ABV, our 2024 Blood Red Barbera is not for the weak of heart or the timid wine drinker.

## Estate Barbera 2024 \$85. Club: \$63

When sampling through all our potential candidates for winter futures, this wine was almost unanimously our favorite. Our latest Estate Barbera hearkens back to a more traditional style of Barbera, bright and zippy, yet still fruit-forward and intense. Mouth-watering flavors of freshly-picked cherry and black raspberry are accentuated by a lingering, toasty finish. This might be our most-balanced and impressive version of Estate Barbera to date, and we'll definitely be entering it into wine competitions next year.

## Winemaker's Select Syrah 2024 \$75. Club: \$56

Our 2018 Winemaker's Select Syrah was made from the same fruit as this current Syrah, and won Best of the Best/Double Platinum. We just received notice from Great Northwest Wine that our 2023 Winemaker's Select Syrah has also won Double Platinum in this year's competition. Inky-dark and tooth-staining fruit provides ripe flavors of blackberry cordial and black fig paste. The tannins are present but soft, allowing this special wine to be enjoyed immediately or saved for a future treat.
