





BRIEF ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Leh | Welcome to the Top of the World

After arrival, reach the designated hotel in Leh.

Gradually get acclimatized to the climate.

Later in the evening, visit the Leh Market, Leh Palace, and Shanti Stupa on your own.

Have delicious dinner at the hotel.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Leh.



Day 2: Leh to Sham Valley | Exploring Borders of Leh

Begin your day early with a delicious breakfast and prepare for an adventurous ride to the legendary 'Sham Valley'.

Visit the confluence of the Zanskar-Indus Rivers, which is also the world highest river rafting point

Experience the world-famous Hall of fame and learn more about the Indo-Pak wars and the martyrs

Visit the Magnetic Hill, where you can witness the unusual phenomenon of vehicles sliding uphill on neutral gear

While returning to Leh, enjoy delicious langar at Gurudwara Pathar Sahib.

Later, enjoy dinner after you have experienced a day full of activities and thrill.

Overnight stay at hotel in Leh.



Day 3: Leh to Nubra Valley via Khardung-La Pass | A Drive to the World's Highest Motorable Road (18000 ft.)

After breakfast in the hotel, prepare yourself for the ultimate adventure

The journey from Leh to Nubra falls on a very scenic route

Known as the gateway to the Shyok and Nubra valleys, the Khardung-Lapass is the world's highest all-season motorable road

As you descend from Khardung-la, experience the white sand dunes in Nubra and enjoy a ride of the double-humped camel, exclusively found in Ladakh

Later enjoy camping under the sky full of stars

Overnight stay at the campsite in Nubra Valley.



Day 4: Nubra Valley to Pangong Lake | Relive the Bollywood Moments

In the morning after breakfast, ride to Pangong Lake on the Indo-China border

The lake is a major attraction of the region and is amongst the highest altitude saline water lakes in the world and changes colors from shades of blue to green to red

Enjoy the scenic beauty with the view of the shyok river on one side and the mountains on another side

Featured in movies like 3-idiots and Jab Tak Hai Jaan, enjoy the place in Bollywood style and take a picture with the famous 3-idiots scooter.

Overnight stay at a campsite near Pangong Lake/Tangste.



Day 5: Pangong Lake to Leh | Via Chang La Pass

Wake up in the morning to the beautiful Pangong Lake view
The journey from Pangong Lake back to Leh takes you via Chang La, a
mountain pass situated at an altitude of 17,590 feet (5360 meters).

Visit, known to be the largest Tibetan monastery in Ladakh, visit Thiksey monastery housing several stupas, statues, and other Buddhist artifacts in its 12 story structure


Reach Leh and enjoy a delicious dinner at the hotel Overnight stay at a hotel in Leh.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO FOR 6 DAYS LADAKH BIKE TRIP:-

- Don't forget to bring your Driving License.
- Valid Identity Proof for being an Indian citizen & 2 or 3
 passport-size color photographs of both the rider & the pillion.
- Carry some woolen & warm clothes with you like sweaters, jackets, high boots, etc. to protect your body from catching a cold.

- Persons having Heart problems & Back related issues are not recommended to participate in this Trip.
- Consumption of alcohol before or at the time riding bikes is not going to be allowed.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR LADAKH BIKE TRIP

 Full Face Helmet with clear Visor: Get a good quality full face helmet for the ride to protect you from the cold winds while riding.

 Riding Gloves: Gloves is necessary for the ride, as after a while you might feel cold, and if not it gives a good grip and protect your hands in case you fall down.

- Elbow and Knee Guard: If you are not comfortable wearing a riding jacket and riding pants, the least you can do is wear elbow and knee guards.
- Riding Shoes: Make sure you wear riding shoes, and if not then gumboots with thermal socks will serve the purpose.
- Sunscreen Lotion: UV rays at high altitude keeps getting harsh which is quite damaging to the skin. Carry a plus SPF 30, as you don't want a bad tan.

 Water Bottle: It is necessary to drink 4-5 litres of water at high altitude to avoid dehydration. As it will later might result to AMS (Altitude Mountain Sickness) symptoms like nausea, vomiting, headache and burning of eyes. So keep your body hydrated at all times.

- Clothing: Always dress like an onion (dress in layers) at highaltitude, it is better than a thick woollen. Carry at least 2-3 spare shirts, with 1 pair of riding pants, and 1 pair of jeans.
- Cap: Carry a cap to keep yourself protected from the harsh winds while riding. It will protect your forehead, ears and even neck.
- Driving license: This goes without saying,
- carry your DL at all times as it required to show at certain checkpoints.
