



Certified Asbestos Craft Worker / Roofer Technician Course

Program Overview

The course has been approved by the State of California for those who perform removal of asbestos roofing materials. This **8-hour** course is based upon the requirements of the State of California Division of Occupational Safety and Health. The course is designed for the Roofing Contractor's employees that may disturb asbestos containing roofing material.

The student is provided important information about the different types of roofing materials/components that may contain asbestos and the health effects of asbestos exposure. In addition, the student learns specific measures for personal protection, engineering controls and techniques for dealing with asbestos containing roofing materials. Training is accomplished through lectures, use of audiovisual aids, demonstrations and hands-on experience.

Topics covered include:

- introduction to regulations,
- Health effects,

- Personal protective equipment,
- Removal of cementitious shingles, transite boards, felts and flashings, and
- Safety issues as it relates to roofing work.

Courses are offered in both English and Spanish.
