- Excellent knowledge of legislations and procedures
- Excellent knowledge of potentially hazardous materials or practices
- At least Five (5) years of experience in producing reports
- Experience with writing policies or writing job specific Job Safety Analysis (JSA) or Job Task Analysis (JTA) or work procedures where employee safety and health was part of the procedures
- Familiarity with conducting data analysis and reporting statistics
- Ten years of specific experience with a GED / Apprentice / On-The-Job / Skills Training / or five (5) years with an AA / BSc / BA / MS or Three (3) Years of specific experience as a PHD in safety, health or environmental management field

- Certificate in occupational health and safety from OSHA or an Authorized OSHA Training Institute Education Center (OTIEC), NEBOSH, National Safety Institute or similar training organizations. Note: Training certificates from the National Association of Safety Professionals (NASP) or the International Association of Safety Professionals (IASP) will not be accepted.
- Pass a four (4) hour - Two Hundred & Fifty (250) question, proctored examination and pass at an 80%. You are allowed three attempts to pass this examination. Should you not pass this examination after three attempts, you may retake this course for fifty (50) percent of the listed price and try again.
