



Certified Occupational Industrial Hygiene Specialist Course

Course Objectives:

The IASHEP Certified Occupational Industrial Hygiene Specialist training course is a four day introduction to fundamental industrial hygiene principles. It is designed for industrial hygienists, occupational industrial hygienist technicians, safety professionals or others who may have industrial hygiene responsibilities.

Hands-on training is combined with classroom lectures to ensure that students understand how basic air contaminants, noise, ventilation, heat and illumination surveys are planned and measurements conducted. Students will then be able to conduct measurements, or better understand how to specify requirements for obtaining contractual industrial hygiene services.

- Use of Direct-Read Instruments for Air Sampling

- Heat Stress Evaluation
- Illumination Evaluation
