A Certified Safety and Health Administrator plans, organizes, coordinates, and implements comprehensive safety and loss control/prevention programs and activities for the employer, implements program goals and objectives; evaluates safety training requirements; inspects facilities and equipment for compliance with mandated safety regulations; performs a variety of administrative tasks in support of assigned area of responsibility; and exercises fairly independent judgment and decision making in the course of duties performed.
