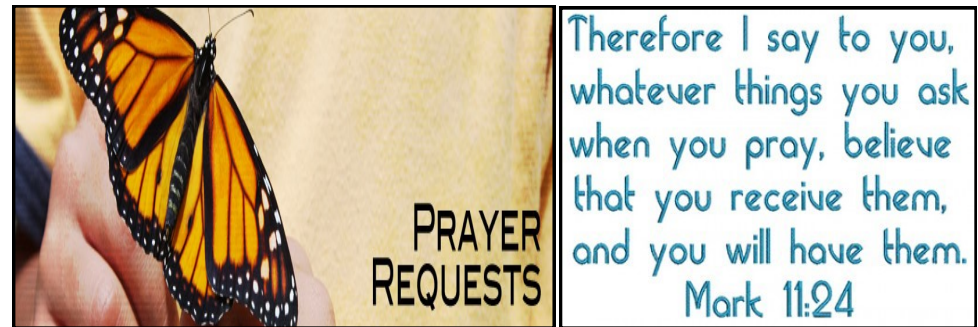

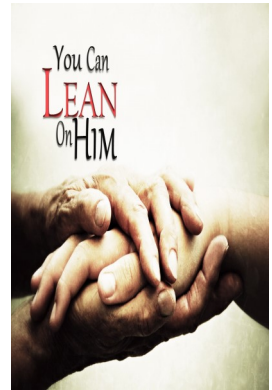
PROCESSIONAL HYMN.....LEANING ON THE EVERLASTING ARMS

SERMON HYMN.....AMAZING GRACE (my chains are gone)

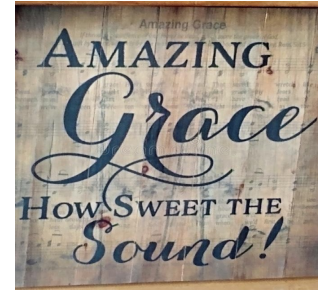
Amazing grace, how sweet the sound

Unending love, amazing grace.



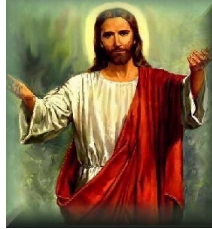
