

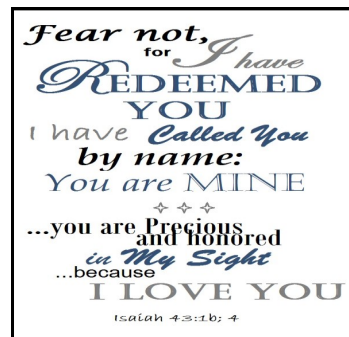

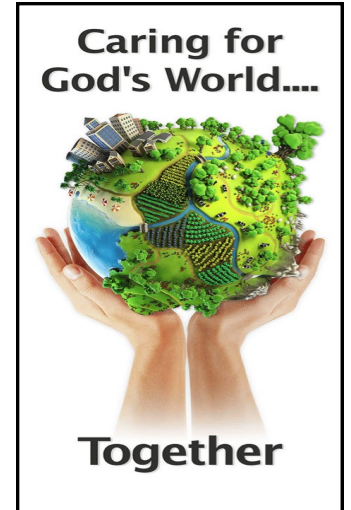
PROCESSIONAL HYMNTHIS IS MY FATHERS WORLD

God is the ruler yet.

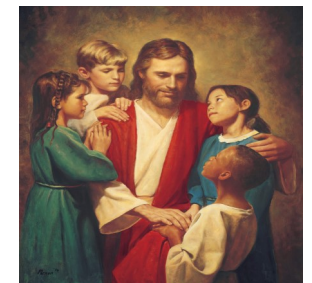

They are weak, but He is strong.

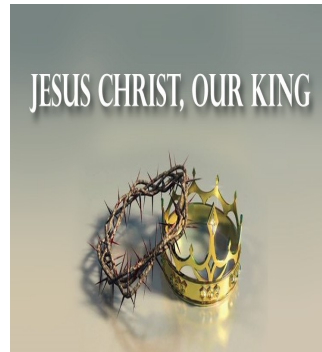
