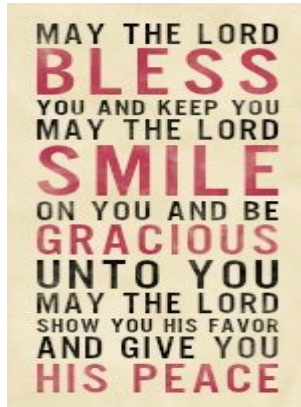

His hand the wonders wrought

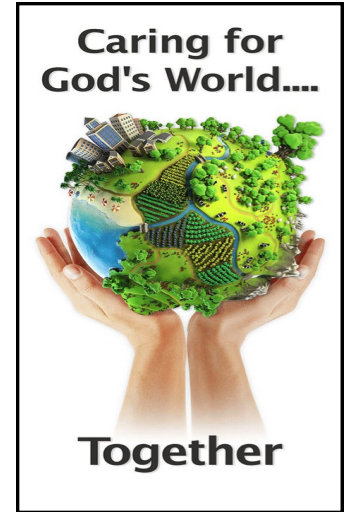
This is my Father's world;
