-ID for ALL Household members.

-Proof of total income earned for entire household.(2020 IRS forms, check stubs, etc.)

-Proof of C-19 Pandemic Financial Hardship.(Check stubs, Unemployment insurance, Employer's Letter, school expenses,child care etc.)

-Proof of unemployment for C-19 must be after 3.20.20.

-Entire Current Lease, signed and dated by Tenant(s) and Landlord.

-Copies of most-recent utility bills.

-For City of Phoenix ERA: Applicant MUST SHOW proof of unmet and past-due rent or utility obligations. Written documentation REQUIRED.

-Affidavit(s) required for households with more than 2 adults if not all are working or show no income.
