HomeBase Surprise is an expansion of NAC's comprehensive program for homeless youth at HomeBase in Central Phoenix. Through street outreach, referrals from community agencies, and word of mouth, homeless youth enter the program which provides an array of services designed to support and empower. Resident services including physical, mental, and behavioral health assessments, three meals a day, along with safe dormitory-style living are key elements of the wraparound care we provide. Case managers work closely with youth on educational goals, financial literacy, employment opportunities to support permanent housing in the future. The same community partners who have worked with youth on the Central Campus since 2012 are joining HomeBase Surprise to offer their services at this location. Together, we offer homeless youth the safety, stability, and life skills to lead independent, healthy lives.
