Family Dining Room

- Welcome to the Family Dining Room. You must have a child under the age of 18 to enter this dining room. Once you enter, you will receive a table form from the Welcome Desk. It has your table number on it. Seat yourself, please.
- You may visit the salad bar throughout the night at your leisure.
- There will be menus on the table or the screen on the wall. Volunteer servers will visit your table to take your food order. Second helpings of meal 1 will be available after 5:30pm
- You are responsible for cleaning off your own table. Tablecloths are to be placed in the yellow bin. Silverware in the pan on the cart. Dishes should be scraped and placed on the counter along with cups and pitchers. The condiment caddy with table number goes on the shelf by the salad bar. Please do not remove any decorations from the condiment caddies.
- Do not remove prepared food from the Family Dining Room.

Dream Center

- This is an educational enrichment center for ages 4-17 only.
- We offer tutoring, classes, chess tournaments, nightly activities, and quarterly field trips by age group.
- Bring in proof of age for your child a day or two before their birthday and we can celebrate on their birthday with a gift, song and special cookie. For ages 0-17 only.
- There is a separate area for ages 0-3 years old children. Parents or guardians over 18 must accompany the children in this area. Toys do not leave the play area.
- Children are required to follow rules, be respectful and participate in activities.

Family Information

- In the Hall of Banners where our Family Dining Room and Dream Center reside, we offer Zumba, stage performances, raffles, classes referrals for services and so much more.
- The Family Dining Room is a safe community to bring your family. Please respect this space and the people inside.
- The table form you are given when you enter has information that is crucial to creating services for you and your family. Please complete this form and return it to the Welcome Desk each visit. This form also lets us know when you have visited us 15 times and qualifies you to receive a gift card to offset your gas consumption. Gift cards are one per household with children living in home only.
- Our volunteers are generous with their time, talents and hearts. Please be respectful of them and thank them, when you get a chance.
