Anniversary Announcement **125 Years**

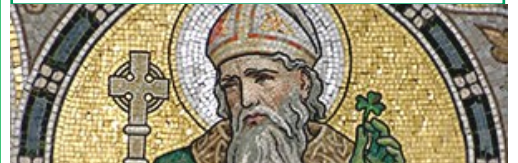
The Sisters of St. Joseph of the Third Order of St. Francis joyfully announce the beginning of our 125th Anniversary Year. This is our time to celebrate God's goodness and to offer thanks for the rich history that has shaped our Congregation. Our journey began July 1, 1901, when a group of Sisters came together to educate the children of Polish immigrants settling in the Midwest. Our legacy took root in Stevens Point, WI where we established our Motherhouse. Our mission evolved to meet the changing needs of the world – expanding from education into health care, pastoral care, and social services -- and reached across the country to fifteen states and beyond, to Brazil, Canada, Peru, Puerto Rico, and South Africa.

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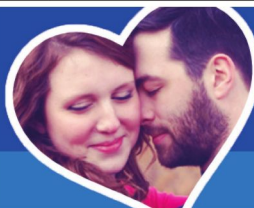


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
