


PROTECTION OF CHILDREN... It remains important for our Church to protect children and young persons from the evils of abuse. The Diocese of FWSB remains committed to upholding and following its guidelines, policies and procedures that were implemented for the protection of children and young people. These can be reviewed on the diocese's website, www.diocesefwsb.org under "Youth Protection." If you have reason to believe that a minor may be a victim of child abuse or neglect, Indiana law requires that you report this to civil authorities. If you or someone you know was abused as a child or young person by an adult, you are encouraged to notify appropriate civil authorities of that abuse. If the alleged abuser is or was a priest or deacon of the Catholic Church, you are encouraged to contact Mary Glowaski, victim assistance coordinator, at 260-399-1458 or mglowaski@diocesefwsb.org; or Rev. Mark Gurtner, vicar general of the Diocese of FWSB, at 260-399-1419; or at mgurtner@diocesefwsb.org; or at PO Box 390, Fort Wayne, IN 46801. The diocese is committed to helping prevent the abuse or neglect of children and young people and to assist those who have suffered harm as a result of such abuse.

The K of C Council 5709/Bernard Westhues Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship awarded to one graduating high school senior each year. It will be awarded this spring at their high school's award ceremony. Scholarship application forms are available at the Parish Office and at the John Glenn High School Counselor's office. We encourage all members of St. Patrick's parish or K of C Council 5709 immediate families who are high school graduating seniors planning on continuing their education at a college, university, or trade school to apply for this scholarship. Scholarship applications need to be turned in to the student's counselor by April 15.
