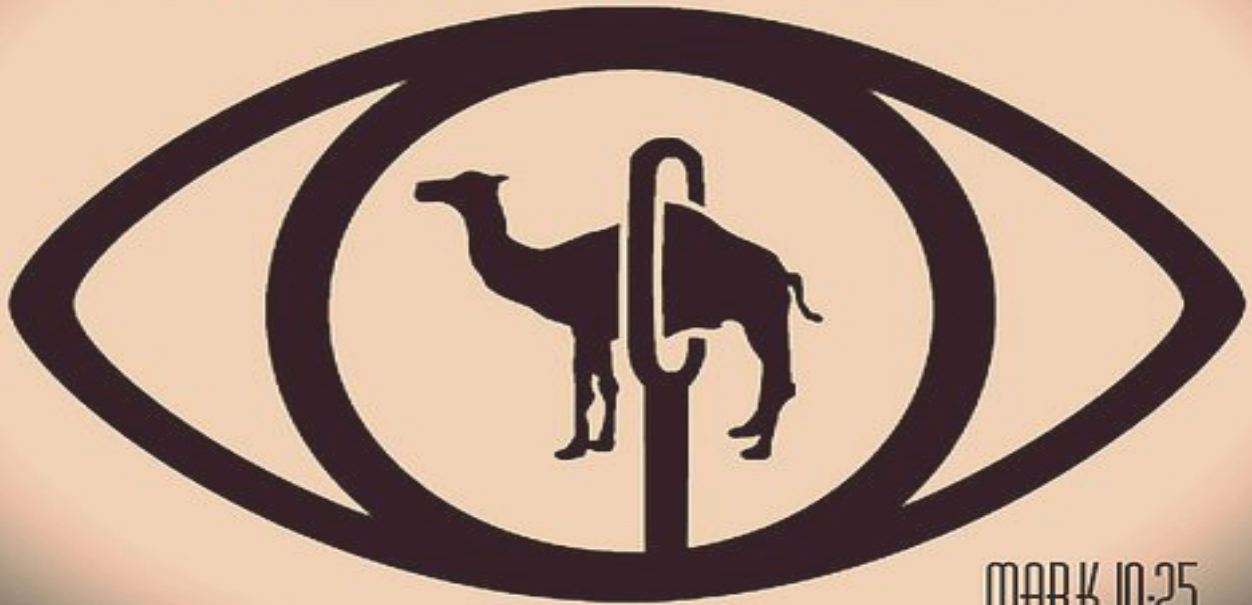

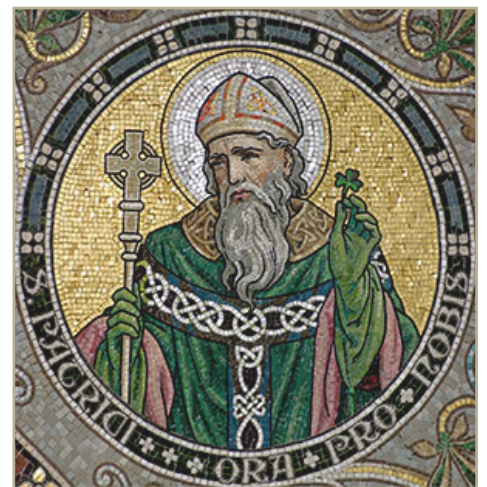

ZAC MAGO FOUNDATION KEEPING THE BEAT SATURDAY'S... Youth Preventative Heart Screenings-Limited Echo & EKG are available on Saturday, November 6, 2021 at the Walkerton Youth Building for those aged 10-25.. You must register ahead of time. Screenings cost is only \$20. This screening is NOT done with normal sports physicals. The Zac Mago Foundation, is a non-profit organization working toward bringing awareness, education and prevention to conditions that cause Sudden Cardiac Arrest in teens. Sudden Cardiac Arrest is the leading cause of death on school campuses. 1 in 300 youth have an undetected heart condition. Heart screenings are painless. Screenings are recommended a minimum of every 2 years, but yearly is ideal. This is not one and done, if you child has not had a screening in the past year, please sign them up.
