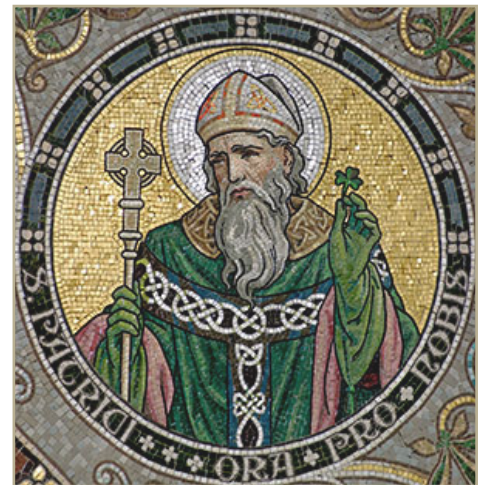

PROTECTION OF CHILDREN ... It remains important for our Church to protect children and young persons from the evils of abuse. The diocese is committed to helping prevent the abuse or neglect of children and young people and to assist those who have suffered harm as a result of such abuse.
