

**CHRIST CHILD SOCIETY, MISHAWAKA...** Every year over 3,500 children in need receive new wardrobes. This service is offered for children ranging in ages from birth through twelve years. Each child receives a bag of new clothing for children ages 1 through 12. Babies receive a layette. Toddlers receive Blanket Sleeper or pajamas, Toddler 2 piece outfit, 7 pairs of underwear (if needed), 7 pairs of socks, Athletic shoes, Winter Coat, Hat & Mittens, Stuffed animal. Older children through age 12 receive Winter Coat, Hat & Gloves, Athletic shoes, 7 pairs of socks, 7 pairs of underwear, T-shirt and Jeans or Leggings or Joggers OR Uniform pants and shirt, Sweatshirt.
