READ POPE LEO XIV'S NEW ENCYCLICAL: *MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS*

Pope Leo XIV has released a new encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas*, reflecting on the growing role of artificial intelligence and technology in our world. In response, Bishop Rhoades encourages the faithful of the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend to read and reflect on the Holy Father's teaching, helping us pursue what is true, good, and beautiful, rather than replacing or diminishing our humanity. As Bishop Rhoades shared, "I pray that this new encyclical will help all people of goodwill reflect more deeply on the use of technology, especially artificial intelligence, in the context of the dignity of the human person and the responsibility to discern carefully the benefits and the risks of technological developments in light of the Gospel and the Church's social teaching." 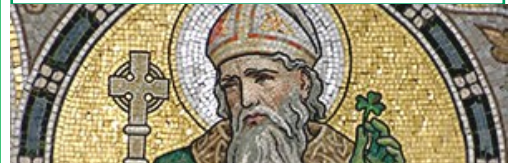
