K of C COUNCIL 5709 SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL AID... Two types of financial aid are available to students of St. Patrick's Parish or St. Patrick's K of C member's immediate families:

The K of C Council 5709/Bernard Westhues Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship awarded to one graduating high school senior each year. It will be awarded this spring at their high school's award ceremony. Scholarship application forms are available at the Parish Office and at the John Glenn High School Counselor's office. We encourage all members of St. Patrick's parish or K of C Council 5709 immediate families who are high school graduating seniors planning on continuing their education at a college, university, or trade school to apply for this scholarship. Scholarship applications need to be turned in to the student's high school counselor by April 15.

Financial aid: to those students whose immediate families are members of St. Patrick's attending any grade of college or trade school or in a Catholic Elementary or High School. K of C Council 5709/ Bernard Westhues Endowment Fund Trustees will distribute approximately \$200/ea as they are able based on the number of applications to eligible students who apply. Financial aid applications are available at the Parish Office. Applications due to the parish office or to deb-bieandtom73@gmail.com by April 30.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION...

- Communicants will remove masks (recommended that they pull them under their chin) before receiving Communion.
- A distance of 6 feet must be maintained between individuals or family units in the Communion procession.

Receiving Communion on the tongue remains an option, but discouraged.


