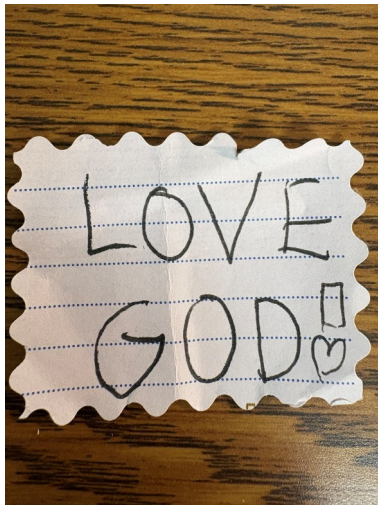

THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IS HERE TO ACCOMPANY IMMIGRANTS AND THEIR FAMILIES IN NEED.

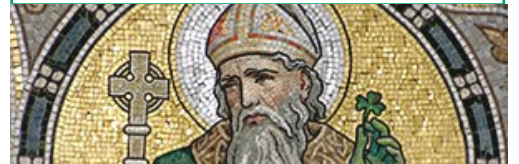
