SAINT OF THE WEEK

Our Lady of Fatima May 13

I recently listened to an audio version of the book Heaven is for Real. I will not go into the amazing experience this young boy went through, but I will share what he repeated over and over to his parents following the ordeal: "Jesus loves children...Jesus really loves the little children...Jesus loves children so much!!" This is made evident by the repeated Marian apparitions three Portuguese children experienced in 1917. Jesus sent his Mother to Francisco, Jacinta and Lucia, to ask them to pray the rosary for world peace, an end to World War I, for sinners and for the conversion of Russia. Our Lady also confided in them three secrets, which were revealed publicly at different times. These apparitions were approved by the local bishop in 1930, at which time they began celebrating her feast day in Portugal. It was added to the calendar of the Catholic Church worldwide in 2002. May Our Lady's words continue to touch the hearts of God's beloved children and motivate us to pray the rosary frequently, begging our Lord for world peace and the conversion of sinners. —Tami Urcia

SAINT OF THE WEEK CATHOLIC RECIPES

Log onto <u>catholiccui-</u> <u>sine.blogspot.com</u> and you can find recipes correlating to the Saints feast day. **For Our Lady of Fatima** there is a Portuguese Dish that sounds delicious! **Carne Vinho de Alhos**

Larne Vinno de Alno Ingredients:

We use country style pork spare ribs but lean pork chops can be used. 1 part red wine vinegar to 2 parts water is the liquid base. For 2 1/2 pounds of meat we have used 1 cup vinegar & 2 cups water. lots of garlic crushed 1 tsp. cumin 1 tsp. allspice 1/2 tsp. cinnamon 1/2 tsp. cloves 1/2 tsp. nutmeg salt & pepper to taste

Add spices to vinegar/water mixture. Mix liquid and add meat. The meat in the marinade should ideally set in the refrigerator for 2 days before cooking to soak up seasonings This is optimal but could be marinated shorter time. Bake covered at 375 degrees until cooked through time will vary by quantity. Pour off drippings and grease at least once during cooking. The finished meat should be without liquid, but not dry. For larger quantities of meat increase water, vinegar, and spices.




