"In the twilight of our lives, we will be judged based on how we loved." - St John of the Cross.
How do you treat others? Do you

take for granted those closest to you? Do you open your eyes to strangers in need, or look the other way?

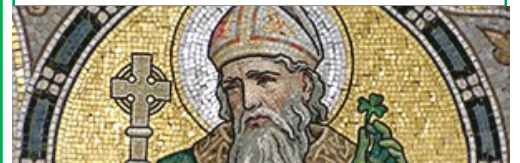

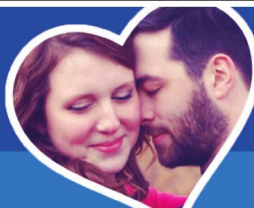
