SYOND 2026

The Spirit is on the move and we need you! The Synod is the opportunity for the faithful to reflect together on one central question: **How is our local church called to live the mission of Christ today and in the years to come?** Beginning in the month of February, The Synodal prayer will be said after the Prayer of the Faithful weekly. Thereafter, beginning March 1st, it will be said at the beginning of every month. The **Parish Synod Meeting** will take place on Sunday, **March 1st from 2-3:30 pm in Letko Hall**. There we will have members from the Parish Council lead us in group discussion. It is important to have your reflection booklet completed. If you do not have a booklet there are more in the back of the church. There is also a sign up sheet for the Synod Meeting. It is very **important to have full participation at this meeting** so we can have a great presence in our diocese.

LOCAL FOOD PANTRY

A letter from The Christian Community Pantry was sent to us giving thanks for contributing \$1,644 in the month of January. The first scheduled Pantry Day in 2026 was extremely cold, so care was taken that families did not have to wait outside. Despite the cold, 58 families representing 140 individuals were served.

A GUIDE TO CATHOLIC MASS BOOK

We have purchased booklets titled; *Welcome to Our Church/Your Guide for The Mass*, which is two books in one. The booklet is perfect for those who are not Catholic, who attend church, but aren't familiar with Catholicism. 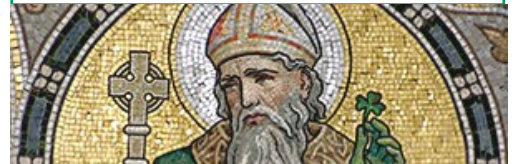
SAINT PATRICK'S DAY DINNER & SOCIAL EVENT
