Well, summer is here! Our museum season was off to a slow start as the opening of the museum had to be delayed due to Township construction projects at Akenac Park. We did begin opening the museum on May 11th. Museum displays have been enhanced. Additionally, we have been painting as well as adding a new display honoring our Korean War Veterans. This display depicts the interior of the Korean war military tent of Hawkeye and Trapper in the M*A*S*H TV series.

The creation of our public research room is well underway. Hoping to open this season, you will be able to research local families, properties and events. Access will be available during times our museum is open or by special request. Access to records, maps and news articles will be available, as well as some computer cataloged files. A research table and chairs are in the research room for your comfort, as well as the availability to copy material of importance.

Our presentation schedule started, as scheduled, and the programs presented so far have been a great success with a large and enthusiastic attendance. Abe Lincoln's visit was most enlightening as well as very entertaining. The presenter, Lou DelBianco, was excellent; we hope to have him back in the future. Jonathan Kruk portrayed a colonial resident of the area and, as always, was informative while being extremely entertaining. Our schedule continued with the second stage of information on the National Recreational Area vs. National Park designation issue. This included updates on recent events by Sandy Hull and me. Remaining 2024 programs will include Kyle Jenks portraying a Continental Soldier and Bill Streeter with "Close Encounters of Birds of Prey." We will not be presenting a September program due to a very special event scheduled in October. We are extremely excited to announce a two day, Living History, Civil War encampment, here at the Park. This will be held on October 12th and 13th. It will include the encampment, musket fire, cannon fire, drilling, hospital demonstrations and more. We will have a food tent with light food and soft drinks available as well. The museum will be open both days. Both the Living History event and the museum will be free of charge and presented rain or shine.

July 18 at 7pm: The Colonial Revolutionary Soldier

We welcome back Kyle Jenks, who presented a wonderful program on James Madison last year. Kyle will be presenting the "*Revolutionary Reminisces of Patriot Soldier Douglas McKenna*." McKenna is an historically inspired

character and Kyle will recount his war experiences in and around the vicinity of the Battle of Conashaugh and other events that led up to it, including Valley Forge.

Aug 11 at 2pm: Close Encounters with Birds of Prey

Here's your chance to see birds of prey up close and learn about them in a safe environment. Bill Streeter, Delaware Valley Raptor Center, will be bringing an assortment of birds for his presentation. The Raptor Center, located in Milford, PA, is a private, not-for-profit, tax-exempt organization dedicated to the conservation of birds of prey (hawks, eagles, owls, falcons, and vultures). They provide a home for our retired education ambassadors and foster parents that were unreleasable due to their injuries.

*M*A*S*H* (Mobile Army Surgical Hospital) was a television series that aired for 11 seasons on CBS from 1972 to 1983. The series, follows a team of doctors, nurses and support staff stationed at the "4077th Mobile Army Surgical Hospital" in Uijeongbu, South Korea, during the Korean War (1950–53). The Swamp is the tent which served as the living quarters for the senior surgical staff of the 4077th M*A*S*H.

Committee Descriptions

- 1. <u>Audit</u>: The Audit Committee of two members, who are not officers, will be appointed by the Executive Committee in October to audit the Treasurer's accounts, and submit a written report at the first Executive meeting of the New Year and the March general meeting.
- 2. <u>Budget</u>: The Budget Committee will include the President, Treasurer, and Ways and Means Chairperson. The committee will prepare the annual budget to be presented in writing at the first Executive Committee meeting of the New Year. After approval by the Executive Committee, the budget will be voted on by the general membership at the March general meeting.
- 3. **Bylaws:** The Bylaws Committee will include the President and 3 other members appointed by the Executive Committee. It shall, periodically review the bylaws and recommend any necessary changes to be voted on by the General Membership.
- 4. <u>Genealogy</u>: The Genealogy Committee shall trace the ancestry of settlers and pioneers of Dingmans Ferry-Delaware Township and vicinity.
- 5. <u>Historian</u>: The Historian is the keeper of records and archives connected with the history of Dingmans Ferry-Delaware Township and vicinity.
- 6. <u>Hospitality</u>: The Hospitality Committee prepares refreshments for various meetings as directed by the Chairperson of Hospitality Committee.
- 7. <u>Library</u>: The Library Committee shall catalogue, maintain and preserve the books, manuscripts and other printed/literary matter of the Society. It shall record information about donations and confirm acknowledgments to donors of gifts. Loaned objects shall be so marked and recorded with the name of the donor.
- 8. <u>Membership</u>: The Membership Committee shall include the Vice President as Chairperson, who will keep an accurate record of members including the date of membership, address, phone numbers and email addresses; send dues notices, collect dues and inform delinquent members of their status. Bylaws are posted on the website under Member Only pages. Members create a unique login to access these documents.
- 9. <u>Museum</u>: The Museum Committee shall be responsible for the museum building, tours and displaying Society items at various locations. The Maintenance team will work with the Museum Committee to maintain and improve the building.
- 10. <u>Nominating</u>: Every two years at the September general meeting, the President shall appoint a Nominating Committee of three members, including the Immediate Past President. This committee shall nominate candidates for offices to be voted upon at the November Annual General Meeting.
- 11. **Photography**: The Photography Committee shall catalogue and maintain and preserve the Society's collection of historic photographs. The costs charged to those wishing duplicate prints shall be periodically reviewed by the Executive Committee.
- 12. <u>Publicity</u>: The Publicity Committee shall oversee the printing and publication of materials pertaining to the Society, and posting events on local bulletin boards and to weekly and monthly publications.
- 13. **Program**: The Program Committee shall arrange for speakers, trips, walking tours and similar programs for the benefit of the Society.
- 14. <u>Ways and Means:</u> The Ways and Means Committee shall raise revenue for the Society through fundraising, donations and grants.
