I hereby apply for membership at the Stockton 99 Speedway and a license to participate in Stockton 99 Speedway activities, including but not limited to competition races, testing and practices, collectively referred to as "Event(s)", in the category indicated on application, access to restricted areas during Events.

DIVISION RULE BOOK. I will make myself familiar with the current DIVISION Rule Book and I agree to abide by such rules as they may be amended from time to time.

NO TRANSFER. I understand that my membership and license are personal to me, that I may not transfer or give it to any other person or entity, that any attempt to transfer, lend or permit any other person or entity to use it shall result in a fine imposed by Stockton 99 Speedway of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) and suspension or termination of the membership and license. In addition, I will INDEMNIFY STOCKTON 99 SPEEDWAY and all related parties for any damages arising in connections with such unauthorized transfer, lending or use.

TAX RESPONSIBILITY. I understand that it is my sole responsibility for reporting all payouts and/or winnings from Stockton 99 Speedway to the IRS on my 2026 taxes as "Other Income". Stockton 99 Speedway will not be sending out 1099-misc forms to remind you of this income.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is to be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California applicable to a contract executed and performed in such State, without going effect to the conflicts of laws principles thereof, and if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

2026 Vehicle Registration Application

Vehicle registration applications will be accepted beginning in January every year at The New Stockton 99 Speedway. There is no additional fee for registration of numbers. Deadline for an owner/.driver to reclaim numbers ran in previous year, will be March 1st of current year. All numbers not yet claimed as of March 1st will become available on a first come first served basis. If you race multiple vehicles or divisions, you must submit a registration application for each vehicle. No numbers will be allowed to be used by multiple cars in that division. Priority will be given to the car/owner that raced the most times in the previous season.

You may only register a one or two digit vehicle number for all divisions with the exception of the Pure Stock Division. Three-digit vehicle numbers are required for the Pure Stock Division. (no duplicate numbers allowed)

Any vehicle using methanol will be required to have an A after the one or two digit number.

You are required to complete a separate application for each division you are registering in order to secure your number for multiple divisions.
