**Blessed Sacrament
Formation of a Building
Committee**

As we look toward the future of our parish, we are exploring potential upgrades and remodeling projects for both the Sanctuary area of the church — particularly the brown wall that currently displays the Crucifix — as well as improvements to the Faith Formation Building. To help move these projects forward, we are forming a Building Committee.

Creating a building committee for a Catholic parish is an important undertaking that requires attention to spiritual, functional, and diocesan considerations. The committee will serve as a liaison between the parish, the pastor, the diocese, and construction professionals throughout the planning process. We are seeking 5-7 individuals who are deeply committed to the mission of the Church and who may possess experience or skills in areas such as construction, finance, law, architecture, engineering, or real estate. In particular, we are seeking a respected and mature leader to serve as chairperson — someone who can guide discussions, manage the group effectively, and help bring members to consensus. Our goal is to form a diverse committee representing a variety of perspectives, backgrounds, and age groups within the parish community.

This process is only in its beginning stages, and there will be opportunities for discussion and questions at the Parish Council Meeting on Thursday, June 25th, at 6:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall.

Anyone interested in volunteering their time and talents to support the growth and future of our church is encouraged to attend.

Pentecost and the Holy Spirit

At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit transforms the apostles. Before Pentecost, they were afraid. After Pentecost, Peter stands before the crowd and preaches Christ crucified and risen. About three thousand people are baptized that day. This same Holy Spirit is still at work in the Church today. Catholics first receive the Holy Spirit in baptism and are strengthened by him in confirmation. Through the Holy Spirit, Christians receive the grace to confess Jesus as Lord, resist sin, live in charity, and bear witness to the Faith. The [gifts of the Holy Spirit](#), traditionally listed as wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord, are not sentimental ideas. They are real helps given by God so that Christians can live as disciples of Christ in a world that often resists him.

What Pentecost Means for Catholics Today

Pentecost is not only something that happened long ago. The same Holy Spirit who descended on the apostles continues to guide the Church, sanctify the faithful, and strengthen Christians to proclaim Jesus Christ.

Pentecost reminds us that the Christian life cannot be lived by human effort alone. We need grace. We need courage. We need the Holy Spirit to renew our hearts and purify our desires.

On Pentecost 2026, Catholics celebrate the Spirit who gave birth to the Church's public mission and who continues to renew the face of the earth. So the proper response is not merely to remember what happened in Acts 2, but to pray with the Church to continue to live it anew each day: Come, Holy Spirit!
