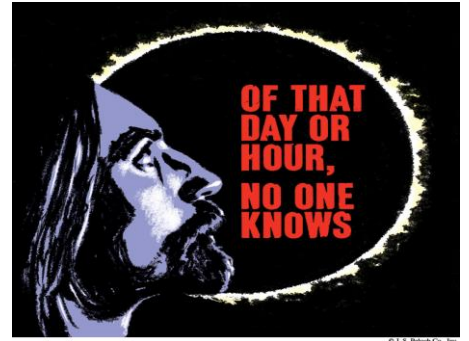

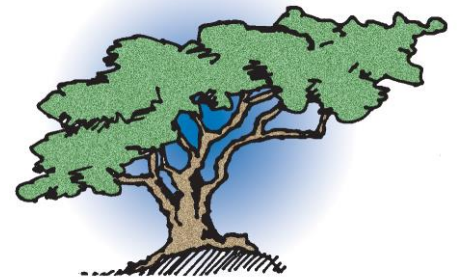

Children's Christmas Play

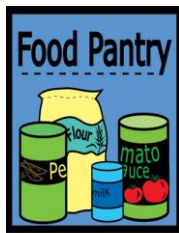
