

Reflection

Today, we hear God's response to the people after the return from exile. The lyrical first reading tells us that God is not won over by rigorous, self-righteous fasts and sacrifices. The fast the Lord wished was as near as one's own kin. The fast the Lord wished was virtually unavoidable-to share bread, to shelter the oppressed and homeless, to clothe the naked. The compassionate person who performed such deeds would find the Lord very near indeed. One could simply call out, and the Lord would say, "Here I am." These familiar compassionate actions from Isaiah are seen in Jesus over and over. Lest we miss it, Jesus reminds us near the end of his public ministry, when he enumer-ates the acts of mercy that Isaiah long ago pointed out. In this last judgment story Jesus adds a new flavor-he identifies with those considered least (Matthew 25:31-46).
