

**GOD’S LAW**

*Scripture has always held God’s law to be the path to human happiness. In today’s first reading, Ezra the priest reads the scroll of the law to the people returned from exile. They weep—then are joyful. Israel’s relationship with God had always been defined by how they kept and lived God’s law. The author of Psalm 96 likewise praises the law of God as the source of wisdom, joy and enlightenment, purity and justice. In his advice to the bickering Corinthians, Paul points out that, just as God has made all parts of a human body essential for the health of the whole, living as “Christ’s body” requires that each member be recognized as necessary for the good of all. Finally, in Luke’s Gospel Jesus claims that the Spirit is sending him to relieve human suffering. Like Ezra, he is reading from a scroll, proclaiming God’s “law” of mercy to those in need.*

## The Synodal Church

"Synodality is an expression of the Church's style. The word "synod" says it all: it means "journeying together". And the movement is the fruit of docility to the Holy spirit, who directs this history, in which all have a part to play". – Pope Francis

Since October 2021, the Archdiocese of San Antonio has worked to create the foundations of a local synodal process that aligns with the framework of the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in October 2023 with the theme, "For a synodal Church: communion, participation and mission" convened by Pope Francis. On the occasion of the Synod of Bishops on Synodality to be celebrated in Rome on 2023, the Holy Spirit gives our local Church the opportunity to reinvigorate the missionary zeal we are called to embody by virtue of our baptism.

Our Church must be one which encounters Christ and one another; that finds herself united as Church around the table of the Eucharist; and is sent by the Spirit to proclaim the Good News of Salvation to all, especially those marginalized in society. These voices are easily and often overlooked in discussions.

The Holy Spirit is moving their hearts also and we must listen to them. As we embark on this Synod on Synodality we pray that each of you promote and become an ambassador in this time by prayer, discernment and dialogue. We are called to listen. Beginning the first weekend of February at the beginning of Mass the Lector will lead us in the Prayer for the Synod. Copies of the Prayer Card will be available in the Pew. Please join us each time to pray for our Church, Our Priest and each other.
