| | | | | | Preparing to disciple others. | |
| | | | | | In preparation for those who come into salvation, we provide a Discipleship Path (A.C.T. Booklet). | |
| | | | | | Four practices can put us on a Discipleship Path—Father Time—spending time with Our Father, Praying the Lord’s Prayer Morning and Night, Gospel Time—reading a chapter of the biographies of Jesus each day, and Requests of 10 words or less—drafting clear requests and thanking God for His answers. | |
| | | | | | As we study Jesus and the Word, we use the S.T.A.R.T.S. process as a way to guide our study and prayers for transformation. | |
| | | | | | | |
| | | | | | We now consider practical matters, including governing issues. | |
| | | | | | Practically, in governing matters, we align with facts about topics, not with any political party. | |
| | | | | | For all topics, we seek primary sources to support the facts. | |
| | | | | | We collate this information onto the Freedom Hub website by topics for easy access. See www.FreedomFocus.info . | |
| | | | | | We distill a few notable headlines to pocket pages for easy and engaging distribution. | |
| | | | | | We watch representatives and candidates to see if they align with these truths, and compile these results into pocket pages. | |
| | | | | | We then carry these pocket pages of headlines to others. | |
| | | | | | We see that there is great potential in exponential outreach. | |
| | | | | | We invite God to put on our hearts 10 others with whom to share truth. | |
| | | | | | In five layers (10x10x10x10x10), we could reach 100,000 people. | |
| | | | | | We provide training to help each of us build a “Team of 10.” | |

| | | | | | In conclusion | |
| | | | | | Towards the end of each meeting we confess sins and shortfalls, and make clear requests of God, asking Him to heal our lives and land. | |
