To Massachusetts Voters,

In recent years voting in Massachusetts has gone from the Voter S.H.I.P. (Same day. Hand count. ID. Paper ballots.) to a very complicated process with many opportunities for error and perhaps even manipulation.

Scroll down slightly to "Who can vote?" Quote: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> "You can vote in the U.S. federal, state, and local elections if you: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> "Are a U.S. citizen (some areas allow non-citizens to vote in local elections only)" There are other requirements in this list, but for this document we are looking at the requirement of citizenship.

3	1	DID YOU KNOW... ...That Massachusetts has implemented Automatic Voter Registration at the Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV), which is adding everyone who applies for a driver's license, learner's permit or ID to the voter rolls.
3	2	DID YOU KNOW... ...That Massachusetts has implemented Automatic Voter Registration at the Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV), which is adding everyone who applies for a driver's license, learner's permit or ID to the voter rolls. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The following is from the website mass.gov.

		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. “Effective January 1, 2023, the VOTES ACT requires the RMV to remove the “opt out” for voting from the drivers licensing application. Applicants that wish to opt out may contact their town/municipality directly....” 2. To access this information: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Go to mass.gov. b. In the large search bar near the bottom of the screen, type in: automatic voter registration. c. At or near the top of the list that comes up, select “Automatic Voter Registration.” 3. As you’ll see in the following block, whether a person is a citizen or not, they are being added to the Massachusetts voter roll. 4. It is up to the person to “opt out” through their town or municipality.
4	1	<p>DID YOU KNOW... ...In the RMV application for an ID, a license, and a learner’s permit, that a person can check off that they are not a citizen, and yet, they will still be added to the voter roll.</p>
4	2	<p>DID YOU KNOW... ...In the RMV application for an ID, a license, and a learner’s permit, that a person can check off that they are not a citizen, and yet, they will still be added to the voter roll.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The following is from the website mass.gov. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. “I must opt out of registering to vote when I receive the automatic voter registration mailing.” It is up to the individual to let their Town Clerk know that they are not a citizen or not eligible to vote. 2. To access this information: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Go to mass.gov. b. In the large search bar near the bottom of the screen, type in: ‘application for a license.’ c. Beware, as the first listing is the application from 2018. It is interesting to note in this application that section “F.” does require an affirmation that a person is a citizen, and otherwise qualified, to be put on the voter roll. This, however, is no longer the case. d. Select: “Learner’s Permit, Driver’s License, and ID Card Application.” e. Scroll down to section “F.” f. Find the above quote near the end of the section.
5	1	<p>DID YOU KNOW... ...That these corrupted voter (RMV) lists go daily to the Town Clerks, who do not have a way to verify citizenship.</p>
6	1	<p>DID YOU KNOW... ...There could be many non-citizens on the Massachusetts voter role.</p>
7	1	<p>DID YOU KNOW... ...Non-citizens on the voter rolls could nullify the Massachusetts results in a Federal Election.</p>

8	1	DID YOU KNOW... ...Nullifying the Massachusetts results in the federal election could mean that the 11 Electoral College votes of Massachusetts would not be counted in the presidential election.
9	1	DID YOU KNOW... ...That 11 electoral votes nullified could change the outcome of the presidential race.
10	1	How to avoid nullification?
11	1	DID YOU KNOW... ...There is a site that verifies citizenship.
12	1	DID YOU KNOW... ...There are 351 cities and towns in Massachusetts.
13	1	DID YOU KNOW... ...10 volunteers from each town could verify all lists for citizenship.
14	1	DID YOU KNOW... ...In addition, the Voter S.H.I.P. (Same day. Hand count. ID. Paper ballot.) could be easily implemented.
