# SUNSET LAKE ASSOCIATION MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING June 6, 2006

**CALL TO ORDER**: President Bob Sons called the meeting to order at \_7:00\_ p.m. Also present for the meeting were Steve Kolsto, George Toepfer, Sam Lamendola,, Bob Gomora, Tony Paquette and Kate Steigerwald. Absent Cheryl Stine & Norman Brand

VISITORS: JimSeggelke #9B, Allan Sharp #3,4, Karla Dorks #87, Ed burg #98, Bill Harris #105-106, John Mount #182, Bill & Linda Urban #36, Ed Snell #286

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**: Bill Hohimer stated that he has been hauling a lot of rock and rip rap. Bill spent a little over a day working at Fred Hagan house. He has ordered chips. Bill reported that he is trying to keep up with the mowing but the days don't seem to be long enough.

OFFICE MANAGER'S REPORT Kristy Barnes stated she has been working on rip rap letters, boat dock letter and unlicensed vehicle letter. Kristy reported that James Williams has never responded to letter. She had one transfer and two orientations. She mentioned that we are still receiving boat stickers and assessments. Kristy also worked on garage sale map and talked to Kent Boyles about who could trap for beavers and muskrats he mentioned Anthony Tate and Fred Bates but this could cost about \$80.00 per animal.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF June 6, 2006**: A motion to approve the minutes of the February was made by \_Steve Kolsto\_ and seconded by \_George Toepfer\_. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **APPROVAL OF BILLS PAID FOR June 2006:**

No report – Cheryl absent- Kristy stated that the expenses were \$9,104.92 and income was \$32,213.88 including escrow which was 27,500.00

Upon a motion by \_\_Sam Lamendola\_ and seconded by \_George Toepfer\_, the Board voted unanimously to approve the bills paid for June.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

AQUATIC CONTROL AND WATER SAFETY: Sam Lamendola stated that he did some patrolling on May 29th he found that 4 or 5 lots didn't have there stickers, so he checked with the office and the stickers were paid for. Sam said that he could not do much since they had already paid for their stickers unless they put their boat in the water. Sam also mentioned that Robson had a loose boat and Denney's tied it up and they came and picked it up. When Sam was patrolling he noticed that the No Wake & Dead Slow signs are fading. He asked can they be replaced or painted. He thought we may need to check this out. Sam wanted to bring it to the board on how to alleviate the problem with the boat stickers. Bill had suggested that the lot number be put on the boat permanently (in the same place) instead of a sticker with the number on it and each year to just issue colored sticker with a year on it. Bob Sons stated that this has been a difficult year with stickers since all of the office changes. After much discussion about the stickers the board will try to implement a new method for the boat stickers. It was said that no light was needed for a canoe and everyone is to have a life jacket. Bob Gomora said that the safety is out of control. Bob Sons stated that all board members can stop anyone as long as they have a flag on their boat. The 1<sup>st</sup> stop is a warning and 2<sup>nd</sup> stop is a fine, then stop by the office so it can be recorded. It was asked how many motorized boats - 2 unless authorized by board. Sam called Jeff Pontnack and he recommended that we stock the lake this year since we diddn't stock it last year. Jeff suggested stocking with walleye, they are more of a predator fish and they will help eliminate the smaller fish such as blue gill and crappie. The best time to stock the lake is September or October.

BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE: George Toepfer stated that he had four permits the first was #65 Hagan for a two room add on, #59A Stine to move a shed, #219 White wanted a hand rail from deck to the dock — George stated that there was no charge for hand rail, #239 Harden wants to extend his boat dock. Bob Sons said that he received a complaint from Joe Dinora about Fred Hagan that the silt was washing into the lake. Bob Sons called contractor and they took care of it.

DAM & GROUNDS COMMITTEE: Norman Brand was absent – no report

FINANCE COMMITTEE: Cheryl Stine was absent – no report

LEGAL & INSURANCE COMMITTEE: Kate Steigerwald stated that she checked on the insurance for the fireworks and the policy was not big enough. Kate also checked with another carrier and state requires a one million dollar contract and county one thousand dollar contract. Bob Sons stated that he will probably have to get his own. Bob Sons will check on this. Kate also mentioned that the fireworks must be 300' away. Bob Sons said that he would be more than 500' away. He said that he would shoot them off the dam.

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**DAM & GROUNDS COMMITTEE:** Norman Brand was absent – no report

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ROADS COMMITTEE: Bob Gomora stated that oil prices are going up and that maybe we should not do the roads at this time. It was suggested by a few board members to raise assessments to \$350.00 to help cover the cost. Bob Sons mentioned the assessments should take care of 1/3 of the roads. Bill stated that oil was about \$1.20 and now it is \$1.25 and driveways were \$1.50 a running foot and now \$2.00 a running foot. Bob Sons said Bill does a good job with handling the rock and oil. The diesel fuel regulates the price, Bill will talk to Curt and will try to start after the July 4<sup>th</sup> that is usually when the season starts.

SANITATION, SHORELINE & BOAT DOCKS COMMITTEE: Tony Paquette stated he has gotten a lot accomplished with septic, rip rap and docks. Thanked Jim & George for their help. Tony indicated that hopefully he will get to everyone by the end of next month. Tony mentioned that the registered letter sent to Jim Williams on the floating boat dock, that there has not been any response to the letter and would like to know what action to take. Bob Sons talked to Dennis Lovely, he was hoping to have the cost on what it would be to have the dock taken out. Bob Sons thought about \$500.00. Karla Dorks said that Mr. Willams was planning on selling his place. It was mentioned that who would pay for the dock to be removed? Bob Sons said that Sunset Lake Association would pay and send Mr. Williams a bill and if he does not pay that when he sells his house it would come out of that with interest. Bob Sons also talked to Dennis Lovely about pulling up the pipes and disposing of styrofoam. Hopefully this will be done this weekend. Tony mentioned that he had been asked by a couple of ladies if anyone had an interest about the old tree. The tree is in need of some TLC and wondered if anyone was interested. Bill Hohimer stated that some big limbs need to be cut and he suggested having someone do this. He also stated that the tree had a lot of poison ivy and oak around it that needed to be sprayed but is afraid to spray due to how it may affect the tree. They thought that the circumference of the tree was about 26' to 27'. Bob Sons suggested tabling this until next meeting.

Upon a motion by Bob Gomora and seconded by Kate Steigerwald to remove James Willaiams boat dock. Motion passed unanimously.

WATER QUALITY & CONSERVATION: Steve Kolsto stated he brought some hand outs on lakes and water sheds if anyone was interested. Steve mentioned that we are getting a healthy crop of coontail which indicates good water quality and also gives cover for the fish. Biologist suggests 40% coverage. Steve stated that people usually want to spray but this is beneficial, it takes nutrients out of the lake. He also said that the coontail is slow growing and that the lake is in good shape. Steve talked with Amy Walkenbach on Lot #17 (which is Steve boss) and the EPA are going to let them use some new equipment to do a D O Temp Meter Test. Steve mentioned the more dissolved oxygen the better and that they will get some water samples to have on profile. He is planning on starting next week He said this will give them a good handle on the lake. Cochran & Wilken test that started in the spring will run through September. Steve will try to map it out.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Bob Sons asked how garage sale went. Kate Steigerwald stated it went well. Bob Sons stated that not many people showed up for the neighborhood watch meeting, hopefully due to the weather. He said the sheriff was very informational. Bob Sons would like to have a drug awareness display about meth, the dangers of and to make people aware of the drug. The division of lot 71 & half of 72 went through. We are not having a good response to the CPR classes. Several people said they were interested but not many signed up. Bob Sons has been going to the City Council as representative for Sunset Lake to get a better tie with Girard. He will try to get more people interested. Will try for July for CPR classes. Bob Sons stated the meeting with Fickas went well and George Toepfer talked with Tavernor about silt fence. He has put up the silt fence. Bob Sons said we will wait and see what happens with drainage. Steve Kolsto ask about the sign taken down (No Ski Turn Around) will it be replaced. Bob said that it should be replaced especially with the new people. It was stated that the signs No Wake & No Ski Area that is what the buoys were for. Bob Sons suggested that some signs need to go and some need to stay. Bob Sons and Sam Lamendola will go and take a look at the signs. Bob Gomora stated that the unlicensed red truck on lot #137 is still there. Letter was sent to them will check to see how long they have to respond.. Karla Dorks ask about two big black dogs and what can be done. Bob Sons said to call the office or a board member and let them know and they can pick them up. Karla also ask about geese and how to get rid of them. Bill has disturbed several nests.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Bob Sons mentioned that he wanted to entertain an issue about how many dogs per household. There is someone that is interested in moving out here that has about 13 to 14 dogs. Bob Sons said that this could be a problem out here. Bob wanted to have everyone think about this and vote on it next month. Bob Sons mentioned that a young kid would like the old computer. He wanted to know if the board would like to donate this to him.

Upon a motion by Bob Gomora and seconded by George Toepfer, to donate the computer. Motion passed unanimously.

Bob Sons stated that the lawn mower is getting old. The mower has about 1700 hours it needs to be over hauled and new clutch. This was the mower that was hit when the building was wrecked. It is starting to cost more in maintenance. The mower is 5 years old. Bob stated that we could get \$5,500.00 for the old mower. Bob checked and we could get the same kind of mower and the same service from Konneker-Brown. Bob Sons will check and make sure funds are there before we purchase.

Upon a motion by Kate Steigerwald and seconed by Sam Lamendola, to purchase a new mower. Motion passed unanimously.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Bill Hohimer stated that he received some calls about Lot #11(Veera Kriisa) that she cut down a tree. Jared from B & R Construction talked about a steel wall for the shoreline in place of rip rap. They would like to mail out brochures and see what kind of interest the people have. Also they would need permission to put their boat on the lake. It was stated that no permits were needed for the use of their boat.

Upon a motion by Cheryl Stine and seconded by George Toepfer, the Board voted unanimously to approve B & R Construction to put a boat on Sunset Lake.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Bill Hohimer stated he rocked and oiled seven driveways on August 11, 2006. Louis Marsch did the oiling and spreading. The cost was \$7,462.58. The road expenses were 5,609.86 and the income from the driveways was 1,852.72. We have also taken in about 1,422.00 of income with rock, rip rap & CA6. Bill stated that a lot of the cost would go back into the roads account. Bill has used the rest of the black patch, most in front of the hall. He mentioned that he picked up a dog and returned to the owner. He has also been receiving a lot of phone calls on the weeds. Bill fixed the line around the tower.

**OFFICE MANAGER'S REPORT** Kristy Barnes stated she has been working on mowing letter Lot #212, rip rap letter Lot #96 and letter to Mr. Garbett for dumping on Sunset Lake property. The letter was sent registered. We haven't received the noticed that it was signed for. She did an orientation with Ken & Eileen Jones and called Royell about antenna, which has been fixed. The hall was rented. We are still selling boat stickers and chlorine tablets.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF <u>August</u> 2006: A motion to approve the minutes of the <u>August</u> was made by \_Steve Kolsto\_ and seconded by \_Norm Brand\_. Motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF BILLS PAID FOR <u>August</u> 2006: Cheryl stated we had to pay for rock & oil, culverts, mulch, weeding, office supplies and escrow the total expenses were 16,150.09 and income was 5,394.65.

Upon a motion by \_Kate Steigerwald\_ and seconded by \_George Toepfer\_, the Board voted unanimously to approve the bills paid for <u>August.</u>

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

AQUATIC CONTROL AND WATER SAFETY: Sam Lamendola stated August 14 he was called about floating dock with drums. The lady was called and it was taken care of the next day. Sam has finish putting up the lake signs. (a total of 34 signs have been put up) There are six additional No Wake signs for future use and five blank sign that are painted for future use also. Sam mentioned that next month was time restock the lake. Sam talked to Jeff Pontnack. He has given him a complete run down on the species and recommendations on the fish he suggests. Jeff suggest 3500 Channel catfish 8 to 10 inches, 750 walleye 8 inches or better every year or every other year. Sam asked Jeff Pontnack about weed problem and stocking grass carp, he did not recommend stocking the grass carp. Sam has the prices on the fish that are to be stocked. Sam suggested keeping it in the state. He would like to have the board recommend what kind of fish they want by Oct 1.

Bob Sons mentioned that the information that was sent out about the kite tubes was not an issue since there is not enough boat power to pull them.

**BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE:** George Toepfer stated that he had one request on Lot #71 & 72 for new home. It is staked out. George also mentioned that Lot #79 & 38 are looking good.

DAM & GROUNDS COMMITTEE: Norman Brand stated no report at this time.

FINANCE COMMITTEE: Cheryl Stine stated everything looks good. The income is doing well, fines & penalties, interest income & earned by maintenance man is all up. Total income is at 99.5%. Cheryl said there is an issue with the employment taxes they are not working with our software. She suggested using some profession fees to get it fixed and add payroll program to the computer. Bob Sons will call and check on program.

**LEGAL & INSURANCE COMMITTEE**: Kate Steigerwald stated nothing to report. Kate did mention she has moved to Springfield and would need to resign from the board. Kate thanked everyone for the past few years.

**ROADS COMMITTEE:** Bob Gomora stated that they will be getting ready for the winter. They will be ordering salt and checking vehicles.

**SANITATION, SHORELINE & BOAT DOCKS COMMITTEE**: Tony Paquette stated that Mrs. Pharris rip rap is being done by Matt & Mitch Munchalfen & Kenny Reardon. They should be finishing up fairly soon. Not much else going on.

Bill Hohimer mentioned that Rick Maguire will be putting in four septics. (Jones, Dunham, Truax, Musgrove)

WATER QUALITY & CONSERVATION: Steve Kolsto stated that they went out two to three weeks ago and did water test. They did a test for the clarity in three spots- the island and by No Wake on east end and also the other end by the No Wake sign. At the first sight it was 54 inches (which Steve said is excellent) the other two sights were 51" and 50". He mentioned the water is so clear and maybe that is the reason why weeds are starting to grow. He said we still need to address the weeds.

OLD BUSINESS: Bob Sons said that there are a few options how to handle the weeds. 1<sup>ST</sup> To hire someone and have them do it. Bob Sons called some people only one called back. He was from Indiana and for two cuts per year it was \$50,000.00 the 2<sup>nd</sup> To hire someone to poison the weed as a contact or go for the root. For the weed control it would take about two weeks and the root would take about 30 to 35 days. The gentleman that Bob talked to said to have the lake poisoned (figuring about 30 acres) it may cost around \$8,000.00 to \$12,000.00. If we go this route we may be able to get it for under \$8,000.00. Bob also talked to Amy Walkenbach from EPA about the weeds. She said if you poison weeds they will rot and go to the bottom of the lake and put nutrients in the lake and will make the weeds grow again. So they suggested pulling weeds. Another suggestion was to get volunteers to help pull the weeds with rakes. It was also mentioned to do both pull the weeds and poison. Someone also ask about lowering the lake. After much discussion about the weeds they will bring it up at the annual meeting. There may have to be a special assessment for the weeds.

Cheryl put together a estimated budget for 2007. The board looked it over with the possibility of assessments going up three dollars.

Upon a motion by Sam Lamendola and seconded by George Toepfer, the board unanimously approve to accept the budget.

Dunham construction time is up. A fine was discussed and voted on. Dunham's will be fined \$250.00 for not being finished by the deadline. Then for next three months if they are still not finished there will be a \$100.00 per month. After the three months and still not finished the fine will continue to go up to \$200.00 per month, (for three months) and so on, until they are finished. (The fine will be in three month intervals) For Dunham's home to be finished he is to have windows, siding, roof, dirt pile is spread out and property cleaned up. A letter will be sent letting them know.

Upon a motion by Cheryl Stine and seconded by Norm Brand, the board unanimously agreed to fine Robert & Shirley Dunham, Lot #39 & 40 for the construction of their home not finished.

Sam and his committee will go over the prices and what kind of fish to purchase. They will meet before Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> to decide.

Norm Brand talked about the fishing tournament. He needs volunteers to go door to door and pass out flyers. The tournament will be sponsored by Mary Centko for the prize money. The entry fees will go into the fireworks fund. Hank Sutton is sponsoring the Lake Festival. Environmental Agency has donated also. The new bait shop will being donating items for children that don't win the contest. All Electric would like to donate to the kids too. There will be food, tours & different professionals speaking.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Bob Sons discussed about fire rating that had gone up at Sunset Lake. A local insurance company called and said the rates are going to go up. Bob Sons talked to fire chief. The fire hydrant needs to be 6 inch or 8 inch for the fire department to hook up to. Some of the lake has 4 inch flush hydrants that the fire department can not hook up to. Bob suggested for people to check with their insurance to see if it went up. The lower the number the better the rate.

**TRANSFERS**: The following transfers were approved upon motion by \_Cheryl Stine\_ and seconded by \_Steve Kolsto \_.

The Board agreed unanimously.
