A message from Chaplain Mindy:

It has been another strong, faithful year for Lutheran Campus Ministry at UD, and we are grateful to God for His abundant blessings!

On March 12-13, we underwent a comprehensive ministry site review, spearheaded by trustworthy and insightful ministry colleagues from the region, Ray Ranker, Beth Barkhau, and Bettye Wolinski, with additional input from our bishop, the Rev. Bill Gohl. Our warmest thanks for your service and deep commitment, exhibited both in the rigorous schedule of interviews and by your thoughtful and comprehensive report! Within the report, we received many commendations for the ministry's areas of strength and recent growth, as well as recommendations for future changes to improve our shared mission and ministry in Christ's name.

One of the report observations made was that we haven't done a very good job of asking for support in recent years, though we do a fine job of thanking and telling. Thus, I am taking this opportunity to be bold! Would you please take a prayerful moment to consider how you might offer financial or in-kind support to LCM in 2019 and beyond? We are very intentional about using your gifts well and faithfully in order to enhance student programs; to encourage student discipleship, service, and leadership development; and to act as careful stewards of our many resources in property, people, faith, and prayer. \$50 funds a Tuesday dinner for students; \$150 provides for our student outreach efforts; \$500 compensates a Peer Minister's work for one semester; \$750 buys all supplies for one year; and a gift of \$1,000 would cover overhead costs for our annual fundraiser. Every dollar is a gift to us! Even if you cannot give at this time, perhaps you would consider remembering LCM in your long-term financial plan or exploring an employer matching program? If you are a member of Thrivent, we invite your sponsorship through Action Team grants. We also love to receive gift cards for places on Main Street, like *Panera* and *Starbucks*, which allow our students to meet for one-on-one conversations and to build community in more informal ways.

With all that said, the best gifts that you can give us are your prayers. Please pray for blessing, guidance, and Christ's daily accompaniment for our nine graduates. Wow! What a talented, inspiring group of young people with beautiful hearts for the Lord! LCM has been a place for them to grow in their knowledge and love of Jesus, while living out that faith through fellowship, discipleship, outreach, and service. It is a privilege and joy to walk and to pray with them at this time in their lives. Thank you for praying with us for present grace and future blessing upon their journeys.
