What We've Accomplished Together

- Official Volunteer Agreement with the USFA.
- Secured **three new grants** to support our operations.
- Grew to 130 active volunteers.
- Removed 10,000+ pounds of illegal trash (tires, oil, chemicals, construction, and household waste).
- Collaborated with UC Davis & USFS to complete the <u>first-ever scientific soil study</u> in San Bernardino National Forest, monitoring for *Phytophthora* ("Sudden Oak Death").
- Maintained fire roads and OHV staging areas.
- Cleaned and monitored recreational shooting areas, removed graffiti, reported and dismantled illegal fire rings. Preventing wildfires in our communities.
- Trained in trail maintenance and construction, now helping restore SBNF hiking trails.
- Partnered with key nonprofits and agencies: Southern California Mountains Foundation, Sierra Club, San Bernardino Mountains Land Trust, Chambers of Commerce, and Heaps Peak Arboretum.
- Began building a **native plant nursery** with SBMLT's Native Plant Committee.
