EPISODE 1

Police Dog Day

It's a day dedicated to our four-legged law enforcers at Neel Veterinary Hospital. Dr. Kishore faces his biggest challenge yet when a critically injured K-9 officer is rushed in. As he fights to save the brave dog's life, he also juggles routine checkups for the police force's canine unit. Meanwhile, a mischievous cat swallows evidence from a crime scene, requiring delicate surgery. At home, Dr. Kishore and his wife nervously attend their first line dancing lesson, preparing for the annual charity ball and providing much-needed comic relief from the day's intensity.

EPISODE 2

Diet Day for Animals

The hospital is overrun with pudgy pooches and fat cats as Dr. Kishore launches a weight loss initiative. He faces a particularly challenging case with an obese dachshund struggling to walk. A diabetic cat requires emergency treatment, highlighting the dangers of pet obesity. In exotic animal news, an overweight iguana presents unique dietary challenges. Dr. Neel and Dr. Kishore clash over traditional versus modern weight loss methods for pets. At home, the Kishore family attends a parent-teacher conference, hilariously misinterpreting American school customs and inadvertently charming the teachers with their enthusiasm.
