Living Waters Community Outreach operates the following community-based programs:

- Weekend Food Baskets – We provide food baskets to 25 to 50 families a week.
- Purity Class for Girls – This program is targeted at eliminating teen pregnancy, building self-respect and self-love in young ladies ages 11 to 17.
- Gentlemen Committed to Christ – This program is targeted to eliminating gang violence and creating self-respect in young men in the community ages 11 to 17.
- Book Scholarships – This program provides books scholarships to college students.
- Life Coaching – This program provides life skills classes to the adults in the community.
- Leadership Through Serving – This program teaches work ethics and leadership skills to young adults 12 through 17. The youth in this program arrive at work at a scheduled time, prepare food baskets and then service the customers for the food pantry by collecting signatures and loading the food baskets in the clients' cars.
- Experience America Travel Club – In this program the youth study a theme for the year and then we travel to destinations to experience the team. Examples of past themes have been Ocean Tides, The Great Lakes and The Mechanics behind Roller Coasters
- Emergency Financial Services – Micro grants of \$300 are awarded to families that are experiencing verifiable emergencies such as fires in the primary home, death of a family member, etc.
- The Homework Lab (launch date TBD) - The Homework Lab will be open Monday, Wednesday, and Friday to provide tutors to the youth in the area to help increase their grades.
