GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Sts. Peter And Paul, Apostles
Matthew 16:13-19

What do you call brothers who are born on the same day? Twins, of course. That is what we celebrate today in the inestimable saints, Peter and Paul. Wait: twins? Yes. The early Church believed that Peter and Paul were martyred in Rome on the same day. Since the day of martyrdom is celebrated as a saints' birth into eternal life, the result is striking: Peter and Paul are twins in God's family, the Church.

Who should care about this? Well, anyone who longs to live in a world marked by love and peace. Remember, the Romans believed that twins, Romulus and Remus, founded their city through an act of fratricide, the former murdering the latter. Sadly, the structures of this fallen world emerge through violence between those who should love each other. But in the Church, a new city has been founded upon this new set of twins, embodying the non-violent power of Jesus' cross and resurrection.

That's why traditional icons represent Peter and Paul in a fraternal and warm embrace. Contrasted with the violence of Rome's founders, it challenges us with a bold claim: do we believe that structures of merciful love are more powerful and lasting than those based on power, violence, and domination? Am I willing to see others in my life as my "twin," with whom I am called to give my life for Christ, or as my rival? Am I committed to living what is embodied in Romulus and Remus, or in Peter and Paul?

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

St. Paul Conversion

Question:

January 25 is the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul and the end of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. What does one have to do with the other?

Answer:

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity consists of eight days beginning January 18 (at that time the feast of the Chair of Peter), and ending on January 25, the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. The Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, founded in the early twentieth century in Graymoor, NY, sought to promote unity among Anglicans and Roman Catholics. Paul James Wattson, a former Episcopalian priest, founded the community, which was formally accepted into the Catholic communion.

The idea for Christian unity soon began to catch on, and by the 1930s, more and more Christians welcomed such a focus. Suggestions for prayer and education are distributed each year, emphasizing a jointly chosen theme. The 1964 Vatican II document on ecumenism, *Unitatis Redintegratio*, gave a great boost to the octave, so that today many Christians worldwide promote and participate in the octave time of prayer.

The emphasis on both Peter and Paul aptly fits into the rationale of the octave. Peter is seen as the source of unity within the Christian tradition. Paul is highlighted due to his vision of bringing all to Christ. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an ideal opportunity to pray for and promote respect, understanding, and, hopefully, eventual unity among Christians. To learn more, visit geii.org.

¿POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICADA

La conversión de San Pablo

Pregunta:

El 25 de enero es la fiesta de la Conversión de San Pablo y la conclusión de la Semana de Oración por la Unidad de los Cristianos. ¿Qué tiene que ver la una con la otra?

Respuesta:

La Semana de Oración por la Unidad de los Cristianos consiste de 8 días, iniciando el 18 de enero (en ese tiempo se celebraba a Cátedra de San Pedro) y concluyendo el 25 de enero, la fiesta de la Conversión de San Pablo. La Congregación de los Frailes Franciscanos de la Expiación, fundada a principios del siglo veinte en Graymoor, Nueva York, buscaba promover la unidad entre los anglicanos y los católicos romanos. Paul James Wattson, sacerdote episcopal converso a la Iglesia Católica, fundó esa comunidad que fue aceptada formalmente dentro de la comunión católica. La idea de orar por la unidad de los cristianos pronto comenzó a fortalecerse y para la década de 1930, más y más cristianos acogieron ese enfoque. Cada año se sugieren y distribuyen intenciones de oración enfatizando un tema escogido conjuntamente. El documento del Concilio Vaticano II sobre el ecumenismo, *Unitatis Redintegratio*, dio un gran impulso a la octava, por lo que actualmente muchos cristianos en todo el mundo promueven y participan en el tiempo de oración de la octava.

El énfasis que ponen San Pedro y San Pablo calza adecuadamente en la lógica de la octava. Pedro es visto como la fuente de unidad dentro de las tradiciones cristianas y San Pablo sobresale por su visión de darle todo a Cristo. La Semana de Oración por la Unidad de los Cristianos es una oportunidad ideal para orar por y promover el respeto, el entendimiento y esperemos que eventualmente produzcan la unidad entre los cristianos. 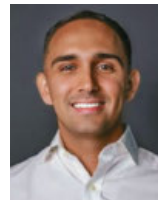
