Make sure to check in for your cruise 14 days before your cruise - Depending on cruise lines check in could be up to 30 days before sailing! (Download the cruise app so you will know exactly when to check in - enter your reservation ID in the app so you can add your cruise itinerary to the app)

CASH is only needed on a cruise for tipping and in the Casino's, you will link your credit or Debit card to your Sign & Sail Card when you do your online check in. (Credit card is preferable)

You will choose your Arrival Time when you do your online check in! PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE TO THE CRUISE PORT AFTER 2pm. The ship leaves at 3:00 - 3:30 pm (depending on the

cruise) you can arrive at the port as early as 10:30 in the morning!

Let's get the Party started early so you won't have to worry about getting left!

At online check in you can pick your beverage package, choose excursions, choose your bed type, and choose your dining room time.
