Luis & Raquel Salazar International Mission Trip Scholarship!

The North Central Baptist Network is pleased to announce that they are accepting applications for the Luis & Raquel

Salazar International Mission Trip Scholarship!

These scholarships are funded by the Luis &Raquel Salazar Memorial Trust for International Missions. This trust was created after the death of Luis Salazar and his daughter, Raquel, in a car accident in 2002. Luis served as the missionary for the Central Region Hispanic Ministry, helped plant Iglesia Bautista Nuevo Amanecer, and both he and his daughter, Raquel, were personally involved in short-term international missions. The Salazar family, along with generous churches and friends from the former Oldham-Trimble Baptist Association created this trust for the purpose of providing partial scholarships for church members in the association to go on shortterm mission trips.

With the creation of the North Central Baptist Network, members of all our Network churches can now apply for a Salazar Mission Trip Scholarship. These partial scholarships will be awarded by the Great Commission Team. There will be two application deadlines during the year: April 15 for trips happening in the late summer and fall, and November 15 for trips happening in the spring and early summer.
